

#### 1. BACKGROUND

- 1.1. Aquaculture Technology Demonstration Centre is an aquaculture facility that was established over thirty years ago as a fish hatchery and was upgraded in February 2013 to serve as a culture technology demonstration facility, a breeding station, a research and training center on different freshwater fish species. The facility covers approximately 47 hectares of land on farm Waschbank 274, Portion 1, with various infrastructure that is in different state of maintenance and renovations needs as there are serious structural defects condition rating.
