	BACKGROUND

DACKGROUND

TCTA's Land and Rights Acquisition ("LRA") seeks to commence with the registration of land and rights acquired in the implementation of The Mokolo Crocodile Water Augmentation Project (MCWAP-1). The process spans over various stages, from early acquisition planning through to registration of transfer/cession of acquired land and rights. Acquisition of land and rights is completed, and the rights are due for registration. The Legal Department requires the appointment of an external service provider from the established list of preferred service providers to execute the work.

The service provider shall be expected to carry out all tasks related to the determination of the value of the rights registrable to the extent that it is required in administering the registration of the rights. Time spent on the task shall

be billable under task 2 (two) of the pricing schedule.

 - iv) If the specific goals have been claimed or obtained on a fraudulent basis or any of the conditions of contract have not been fulfilled, the organ of state may, in addition to any other remedy it may have
 - (a) disqualify the person from the tendering process;
 - (b) recover costs, losses or damages it has incurred or suffered as a result of that person's conduct;
 - (c) cancel the contract and claim any damages which it has suffered as a result of having to make less favourable arrangements due to such cancellation;
 - (d) recommend that the tenderer or contractor, its shareholders and directors, or only the shareholders and directors who acted on a fraudulent basis, be restricted from obtaining business from any organ of state for a period not exceeding 10 years, after the *audi alteram* partem (hear the other side) rule has been applied; and
 - (e) forward the matter for criminal prosecution, if deemed necessary.
