RE: Clarification on Schedule F / Contract Price Adjustment (CPA) Surcharges In reference to the pricing instructions for this tender, locking in fixed long-term pricing for major inputs like structural steel, hot-dip galvanising, and transport carries significant commercial risk due to ongoing geopolitical volatility. Because manufacturers are subject to immediate, non-negotiable mill surcharges and global fuel shocks, we request clarification on the following: If macro-economic or geopolitical events trigger rapid, mid-month cost spikes in these specific	We note the concern regarding the quarterly cycle of CPA and that the adjustment will be for purchase orders created in the new cycle regarding immediate and mid cycle increases imposed by suppliers. The Bid Specification Committee are trying to ensure clear CPA conditions to allow the tenderer to evaluate the risks imposed by the CPA conditions. The Bid Specification Committee cannot always build in factors that cannot be controlled by any of the parties. ie. The risks of mid cycle immediate increases, geo-political volatility etc.

input categories, will the client permit an expedited, out-of-cycle price review outside of standard quarterly or annual adjustment intervals to safeguard security of supply? If so, what is the formal protocol and required documentation to trigger such a review outside of the standard scheduled escalation intervals?	The onus is on the tenderer to assess the risks and include it in the pricing. The contract managers are not allowed to amend or change the contract conditions.
