TENDER DESCRIPTION: SUPPLY, DELIVERY AND CONSTRUCTION OF SLURRY SEAL FOR A MULTI-YEAR PERIOD ENDING JUNE 2028.

Prince Albert Municipality hereby invites tenders for the **SUPPLY, DELIVERY AND CONSTRUCTION OF SLURRY SEAL FOR A MULTI-YEAR PERIOD ENDING JUNE 2028**. The scope of works entails the supply, delivery, and construction of 15mm slurry layer with suitable material and plant.

Tender documents are available at no charge from the Prince Albert Municipality Website at www.pamun.gov.za (Website navigation is as follow: Procurement, Tenders available). **Electronic documents will only be available from 28 October 2025 at 12h00. It is the responsibility of prospective bidders to ensure that documents downloaded electronically are complete at the time of submission, incomplete tender documents will render your bid non-responsive.**

Alternatively, **a set of tender documents (if hard copy is required) must be reserved at least 72 hours prior to the date of the compulsory clarification meeting at the municipality.** A non-refundable fee of R 500.00 (Inclusive of VAT) is payable in cash at the cashiers at the Prince Albert Municipality's Finance Division or via EFT deposit in favour of the Prince Albert Municipality, ABSA Bank, Branch code 632005, and Account number 2640-5600-64. Reference to be used: T169/2025 and company name. Reservation of the document can be done upon receipt of the documentation fee, and the issue of a municipal receipt or acknowledgment. Bidders are required to be registered at the Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB). Only those tenderers who are registered with the CIDB, in a contractor grading designation equal to or higher than a contractor grading designation determined in accordance with the sum tendered, or a value determined in accordance with Regulation 25 (1B) or 25 (7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulations for a **5 CE** or Higher class of construction work are eligible to have their tenders evaluated.

A **compulsory** tender clarification meeting will be held as follow:

Tenderers who arrive after 11H45 will not be allowed to join the clarification meeting.

Bids must be submitted in sealed envelopes, clearly marked with the **TENDER NUMBER AND TENDER DESCRIPTION**.

Bidders that fail to adhere to this requirement, will be disqualified at the bid opening.

Bids must be deposited in the tender box at the Prince Albert Municipality's Finance Division (Thusong Centre, Adderley Street, Prince Albert, 6930). The tender box will be open for depositing as follows:

- Monday to Thursday: 07h30 and 16h00
- Fridays: 07h30 and 15h30.

Bids will be opened immediately after the closing date at the Finance Division Boardroom (Finance Building, Thusong Centre). Late or unmarked bids will not be considered. **Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail and late bids will not be accepted.**

This bid **is subject to functionality / quality scoring**. Bidders must obtain the minimum functionality / quality scoring as indicated in the tender document for the bid to be regarded as responsive. Bids that do not meet the minimum scoring as indicated, will be regarded as non-responsive, and will not be evaluated on price and preference points.

Bids will be evaluated according to the 80/20 preference points system. The bids are subject to the latest Council's Supply Chain Management Policy, the Municipal Preferential Procurement Policy, and the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2022 (Government Gazette 47452, dated 04/11/2022). **Tenderers must be registered on the Central Supplier Database (CSD) if they wish to conduct business with the municipality.**

The preferential points system to be applied (80/20) in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy are as follow:

The Municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to bid and/or re-advertise or to reject any bid or to accept a part of it. The Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest bid or to award a contract to the Bidder scoring the highest number of points.

NO BIDS WILL BE CONSIDERED FROM PERSONS IN THE SERVICE OF THE STATE AS DEFINED IN THE MUNICIPAL SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT REGULATIONS.
