- 1.2 The organ of state reserves the right to request a tenderer, either before a tender is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim regarding preferences, in any manner required by the organ of state.

#### 2. **DEFINITIONS**

- (a) "tender" means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation to provide goods or services through price quotations, competitive tendering process or any other method envisaged in legislation.
- (b) "price" means an amount of money tendered for goods or services and includes all applicabletaxes less all unconditional discounts.
- (c) "Rand value" means the total estimated value of a contract in Rand, calculated at the time of bidinvitation, and includes all applicable taxes.
- (d) "tender for income-generating contracts" means a written offer in the form determined by an organ of state in response to an invitation for the origination of incomegenerating contracts through any method envisaged in legislation that will result in a legal agreement between the organ of state and athird party that produces revenue for the organ of state, and includes, but is not limited to, leasing and disposal of assets and concession contracts, excluding direct sales and disposal of assets through public auctions; and
- (e) "The Act" means the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000 (Act No. 5 of 2000).

# Specification for supply and installation of networking and security

# 1. Background

The Moses Kotane Institute is an entity of the KwaZulu-Natal Provincial Government through the Department of Economic Development, Tourism and Environmental Affairs (EDTEA). Its mandate is to conduct world class research that responds to the needs of the provincial economy.

Moses Kotane Institute is pleased to invite you to submit your quotation for supply and installation of networking and security at Nquthu local municipality.

#### 2. Scope of work

The below list contains the expected requirements for the Digital Centre in Nguthu.

#### The scope of work should incorporate the following:

#### 2.1. Networking

- a) Installing 12 CAT 6 Network points and terminations with twin RJ45 network wall boxes
- b) Trunking based on requirements.
- c) 13 X 15A electrical socket red plug for computers (10 to power computers, 1 for smart board and 3D printer, 1 for facilitator desk and 1 for BYOD desks, CoC will be required for all electrical work)
- d) Smart UPS to carry load (offline, 2100 Watt, 3000 VA) for at least 30 minutes after power cut.
- e) 1 X Patch Panel C6 UTP 24 port PCB
- f) 1 X Brush Panel
- g) Cable labelling on both sides as per current standard
- h) Cable Test & printed result
- i) 1 X 24 Port Network Switch (PoE)
- j) CISCO Meraki MX67 or similar Network Firewall
- k) Wall Mounted 12u network cabinet with Fans and lockable glass door.
