Napoli win Rogers Tshivhase Cup

MCT Napoli FC were crowned 2025 champions of the Rogers Tshivhase Soccer Tournament at the Jack Lavhengwa Sports Grounds in Khayathi last Saturday, beating Tshivhase Green Mambas 3-1 in the final. Napoli received R10,000, a floating trophy and gold

medals, while Green Mambas took home R5,000 and silver medals. Semi-finalists Mandala Young Vultures and Fondwe Mighty Blues each received R1,500.

Local traditional leader Musanda Vho-Miriyavhava Tshivhase said the tournament was held in remembrance of the late Rogers Tshivhase, former chairperson of the Limpopo Youth

Commission and chief whip of the Thulamela Local Municipality, who passed away in 2017 after a short illness. Floyd Tshivhase, one of the organisers, said the tournament would become an annual event, with sponsorship and the number of participating teams set to increase. Next year, the tournament will expand from four to eight teams.

Phophi Nematangari leads Baby Proteas to their best-ever finish

Phophi Nematangari, an U/21 netballer from Duthuni currently studying at the University of Pretoria, played a key role in the SPAR Baby Proteas' historic performance at the 2025 Netball World Youth Cup in Gibraltar (19-28 September). South Africa achieved fourth place — the highest finish in the tournament's history.

Nematangari, who began playing netball early in life, captained the Baby Proteas in the tournament. Before Gibraltar, she toured with the side to Lesotho and Malawi in 2021 and 2022, winning gold medals. Earlier this year, she was part of the squad that faced Jamaica's U/21s in a preparation series.

For Nematangari, sport is about more than medals. It has taught her strength and self-belief, especially as a young woman balancing sport and education. After matriculating with high marks, she chose to attend university while continuing to compete.

She offers advice to young people: stay focused on your goals. "Even if your talent is not in sport, engaging in sport and travelling will expose you to the outside world," she says.

Mamu's general secretary, Mr Jafer Mamugudubi, thanked the sponsors who made the tournament possible.



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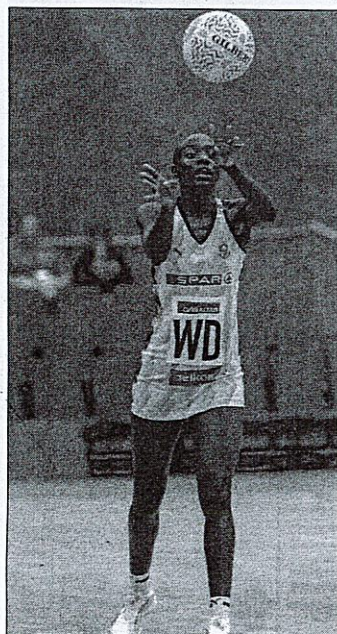
