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Why This Panel?



SCOPE OF WORK

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- Projects classified as follows:

“**Surfacing Works**” - Projects which include the construction of new pavement layers which are all asphalt layers, or layers which may be described as bituminous surfacing's such as slurries, single seals, microsurfacing's etc. shall be classified under “Surfacing Works”.

“**Recycling Works**” - Projects which include construction of BSM (Bitumen Stabilised Material) layers shall be classified under “Recycling Works”. This category shall include both in-situ recycling and in-plant recycling. This category shall also include cement or lime stabilization of pavement layers, and the construction of asphalt layers.



SCOPE OF WORK

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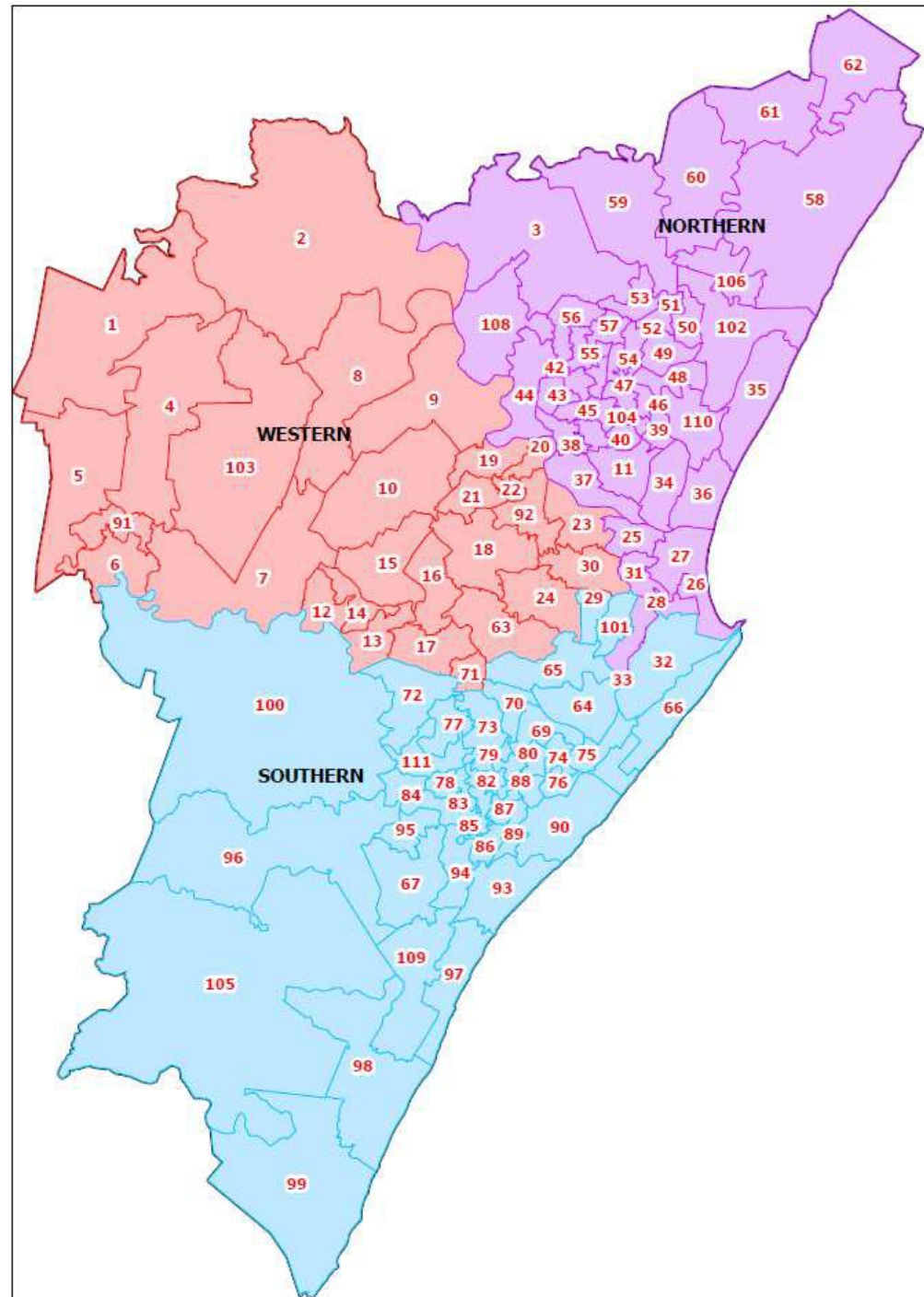
- Projects classified as follows :

“Granular Works” - the construction of new granular pavement layers above the formation level (i.e. Base and/or Subbase). These works shall include construction of layers using both virgin materials and reuse of existing granular materials.

“Subgrade Improvement Works” - Projects which include improvements/re-construction of the subgrade layers below the formation level. These works shall also involve reconstruction of the layers above formation and the construction of all types of layers shall be covered by this category of rehabilitation.

“Ancillary Works” - Projects where the scope of works is not rehabilitation of pavement layers shall be classified under “Ancillary Works”. Examples of the projects this category is intended to cover include raising/lowering of services, construction/re-construction of sidewalks etc

WORK PACKAGE ORDER (WPO) PROCESS

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How Works Will Be Issued

- WPO's based on **submitted rates**
- Issued to **most responsive panel contractor**
- May have **up to 3 WPOs at once** – more if capacity proven
- Includes **CSCG targets** (10–30% subcontracting)
- **Community Liaison Officer (CLO)** required
- **Local labour** ≥ 50% of unskilled workforce

Key Staff Requirements for WPOs:

- **Contracts Manager:** 10+ years road construction / 7+ years of road rehabilitation experience, ECSA/SACPCMP registered in specified categories
- **Construction Manager:** 5+ years road construction / 3+ years of road rehabilitation experience, ECSA/SACPCMP registered in specified categories
- CVs submitted for approval before commencement

Performance Monitoring

- KPIs: time, cost, quality, safety, CSCG achievement
- Penalties for non-compliance – CSCG, traffic, late completion etc
