# For proposals for the development of Vhembe Convention Centre

FEASIBILITY STUDY

#### 1. Purpose

To develop a feasibility study for the development of a Convention Centre within Vhembe District Municipality.

One of the programmes identified in the 2022 Vhembe District Tourism Development and Promotion Strategy is the development of the Vhembe District Convention Centre Feasibility Study. This type of a centre is a purpose-built facility to host events like conferences, conventions, trade shows, exhibitions, meetings, seminars, workshops, banquets, galas, sporting events and festivals.

Currently the entire District Municipality does not have such a facility. It is against this background that proposals for a feasibility study to determine the viability for such a centre are requested.
