Any tender submitted by a person(s) who is in the service of the state or if that person(s) is not a natural person, of which any director, manager, principal shareholder or stakeholder is a person in the service of the state or who is an advisor or consultant contracted with the Municipality shall not be considered in terms of regulation 44 of the Municipal Supply Chain Regulations. Only suppliers who are registered on Central Supplier Database (CSD, visit the CSD website at www.csd.gov.za) can apply for this tender. All suppliers applying for this tender must register on the Municipal database

Prospective service providers are required to ensure full completion and correctness of information when responding to MBD 4 and all other required declarations in the document. The Municipality reserves the right to validate the correctness of the declarations through various databases inclusive of the Central Supplier Database (CSD). Failure to fully complete and/or provision of incorrect information in the declaration will be regarded by the employer as a non-responsive tender.

This tender will be evaluated on a 80/20 preferential points system as per the following criteria: "King Cetshwayo District Municipality strive to achieve the specific goals in line with PPPFA regulations 2022 and the RDP"

Tenders will be opened to public. Tenders received after the due date and time will not be considered.

It will be the tenderer's responsibility to check the document on receipt for completeness and to notify the employer of any discrepancies or omissions. It is the tenderer's responsibility to provide all the data and information requested in the form required, failure to do so may be regarded by the employer as a non-responsive tender. Submissions may only be made to documentation supplied by the Municipality.

The King Cetshwayo District Municipality will strive to achieve targeted procurement in accordance with Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act Regulation 2022.

All communication between the employer and the tenderer shall be in a form that can be read, copied and recorded. All writing shall be in the English Language. The employer shall not take any responsibility for non-receipt of communications from a tenderer.

Tenderers who do not hear from the King Cetshwayo District Municipality within 90 days of the closing date of the tender should consider their tender unsuccessful.
