

are to be attached to the tender document as annexures :

- a) SABS Mark permit certificate or approved alternative authority certificate eg. SATAS; or Referenced Schedule of Type Tests and type tests report cover sheets;
- b) Referenced technical datasheets and sectional drawings for the items offered;

In addition to the above, the tenderer is required to demonstrate compliance with the full extent of the technical specification. In order to be evaluated for compliance with the technical specification, the tenderer must complete **Schedule F.13 (F.13A-F.13C) with the parameters of the cables as requested and not only “tick” or refer to datasheets or specification. It is the responsibility of the tenderer to fully and accurately complete these schedules in order to provide an un-ambiguous tender offer.**

Product Data Sheets, Sectional drawings, Test Reports, SABS (or equivalent) Mark Permit Certificates, must be marked and labelled with the relevant item number as per the Price Schedule.

Any tender submissions that are found to be non-compliant to the Specification for one or more of the items tendered in accordance with 2.3.7 of the Conditions of Tender, and following any necessary clarification in accordance with 2.3.9 of the Conditions of Tender, shall be declared non-responsive for the respective items.

2.2.1.1.7 Provision of samples

2.2.2 Cost of tendering

The CCT will not be liable for any costs incurred in the preparation and submission of a tender offer, including the costs of any testing necessary to demonstrate that aspects of the offer complies with requirements.

2.2.3 Check documents

The documents issued by the CCT for the purpose of a tender offer are listed in the index of this tender document.

Before submission of any tender, the tenderer should check the number of pages, and if any are found to be missing or duplicated, or the figures or writing is indistinct, or if the Price Schedule contains any obvious errors, the tenderer must apply to the CCT at once to have the same rectified.

2.2.4 Confidentiality and copyright of documents

The tenderer shall treat as strictly confidential all matters arising in connection with the tender. Use and copy the documents issued by the CCT only for the purpose of preparing and submitting a tender offer in response to the invitation.

2.2.5 Reference documents

The tenderer shall obtain, as necessary for submitting a tender offer, copies of the latest versions of standards, specifications, Conditions of Contract and other publications, which are not attached but which are incorporated into the tender document(s) by reference.

2.2.6 Acknowledge and comply with notices

The tenderer shall acknowledge receipt of notices to the tender documents, which the CCT may issue, and shall fully comply with all instructions issued in the said notices, and if necessary, apply for an extension of the closing time stated on the front page of the tender document, in order to take the notices into account.
