**1. INTRODUCTION**

- 1.1 This bid is for the supply and delivery of PRINTED FORMS, LABELS AND INFORMATION, EDUCATION & COMMUNICATION (IEC) MATERIAL, to the Free State Department of Health.
- 1.2 The contract has a tenure of 3 years.
- 1.3 Items in this contract will be handled as direct deliveries, implying that the stock will be delivered directly to the ordering institutions.
- 1.4 Receipt of the invitation to bid does not confer any right on any party in respect of the services or in respect of, or against, The Free State Department of Health reserves the right, in its sole discretion:
  - 1.4.1 To withdraw any services from the bid process, to terminate any party's participation in the bid process or to accept or reject any response to this invitation to bid on notice to the bidders without liability to any party; accordingly, parties have no rights, expressed or implied, with respect to any of the services as a result of their participation in the bid process.
  - 1.4.2 To amend the bid process, closing date or any other date at its sole discretion, to cancel the bid or any part of the bid before the bid has been awarded,

**2 LEGISLATIVE AND REGULATORY FRAMEWORK**

This bid and all contracts emanating from it will be subject to the General Conditions of Contract (GCC) issued in accordance with Treasury Regulation 16A published in terms of the Public Finance Management Act (PFMA), 1999 (Act 1 of 1999) as well as the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act 2000 (PPPFA) with its latest 2017 Regulations. The Special Conditions of Contract (SCC) are supplementary to that of General Conditions of Contract. However, where the Special Conditions of Contract conflict with the General Conditions of Contract, the Special Conditions of Contract prevail.

**3. SPECIFICATIONS AND SCOPE OF WORK**

The detailed item specification is as per the attached Technical Specification (As per Section A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J and K) read in conjunction with the schedule of requirements

**4.1 PHASE I: PRE- QUALIFYING CRITERIA FOR PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT**

- 4.1.1 It is a condition of this bid that only one or more of the following bidders may respond to this bid: A bidder having a B-BBEE status level contributor 1 to 3. Bidders are required to complete the preference claim form (SBD 6.1) and submit their original and valid B-BBEE status level verification certificate or a certified copy thereof or sworn affidavit at the closing date and time of the bid in order to prove compliance.
- 4.1.2 Bidders are required to submit proof of B-BBEE status level of contributor. Proof includes original and valid B-BBEE status level verification certificates or certified copies thereof or a sworn affidavit signed by the Exempted Micro Enterprises representative and attested by Commissioner of oaths.
- 4.1.3 A trust, consortium, or joint venture (including unincorporated consortia and joint ventures) must submit a consolidated B-BBEE status level verification certificate. Bidders who submit individual B-BBEE certificates or Sworn affidavit will be disqualified.
- 4.1.4 Public entities and tertiary institutions must also submit their B-BBEE certificate.
- 4.1.5 Non-compliance with the requirement for pre-qualification will invalidate the bid.

## 4.2 PHASE II: MANDATORY AND OTHER STANDARD BIDDING DOCUMENTS REQUIREMENTS

Bidders' must submit all required documents indicated hereunder with the bid documents at the closing date and time of the bid. During this evaluation phase, bidder's responses will be evaluated based on the documents submitted under mandatory requirements. Bidders who fail to comply with any of the mandatory criteria will be disqualified.

### 4.2.1 Standard Bidding Documents

### 4.2.2 Authorisation Declaration / Manufacturer

- a) All bidders must complete the "Authorisation Declaration / Manufacturer" (TCBD 1 and TCBD 1.1) (see Annexure A) in full for all relevant documentation they are offering, sign it and submit it together with the bid response at the closing date and time of the bid invitation.
- b) Any bidder who is sourcing goods or services from a third party must submit a valid Third-Party Undertaking (template provided as TCBD 1.2) (see Annexure A) in full for all relevant goods or services. The letter of undertaking must include but not limited to the following:
  - List of items indicating, item description
  - Letter must be on the manufacturer's or third party's letter head, dated and signed.
  - Have contact person's name, physical address, telephone, and email details.
  - All information on the letter must be in English.
- c) The Free State Department of Health reserves the right to verify any information supplied by the bidder in the Authorisation Declaration / Manufacturer and its Annexures and should the information be found to be false or incorrect, the Free State

Department of Health will exercise any of the remedies available to it in the bid documents and or disqualify the bid.

- d) The bidder must ensure that all financial and supply arrangements for goods or services have been mutually agreed upon between the bidder and the third party. No agreement between the bidder and the third party will be binding on the Free State Department of Health.
- e) Failure to submit a duly completed and signed Authorisation Declaration / Manufacturer, with all required annexure(s), in accordance with the above provisions will invalidate the bid for such goods or services offered.

#### **4.2.3 Pricing Structure and Schedule**

- a) One price is required, and prices quoted must be furnished on the basis of supply and delivery to the ordering institution including VAT.
- b) Prospective bidders must ensure to bid on all items under the sections of their interest as per schedule of requirements
- c) The pricing schedule (see Section A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J and K) provided in this bid forms an integral part of the bid document and bidders must ensure that it is completed without changing the structure thereof.
- d) Conditional discounts offered will not be taken into consideration during evaluation.
- e) Prices submitted for this bid must be filled in on the field provided on the pricing schedules supplied with the bid. Price structures that do not comply with this requirement may invalidate specific sections of the bid.

#### **4.2.4 Tax Compliance Requirements**

- a) It is a condition of this bid that the tax matters of the successful bidder(s) are in order, or that satisfactory arrangements have been made with South African Revenue Service (SARS) to meet the bidder's tax obligations.
- b) The Tax Compliance status requirements are also applicable to potential bidders / individuals who wish to submit bids.
- c) Bidders are required to be registered on the Central Supplier Database (CSD) and Bid Management shall verify the bidder's tax compliance status through the CSD or through SARS.

- d) Where Consortia / Joint Ventures / Sub-Contractors are involved, each party must be registered on the CSD and their tax compliance status will be verified through the CSD or through SARS.

#### **4.3 PHASE III: TECHNICAL EVALUATION**

##### **4.3.1 Standards/Specifications**

- a) Bidders are required to comply with the detailed technical specifications read in conjunction with the schedule of requirements (see Section A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J and K) and non-compliance to the specification requirement will invalidate the items which the compliance is not adhered to.
- b) The Free State Department of Health reserves the right to consider forms which has a justifiable specification deviation and pending the availability of some grams of paper. The deviation to the specification is subject to the deviation not changing the format of the form which must still be acceptable to the end-user. This will therefore be decided upon based on the clinical expertise at the Medical Depot.

##### **4.3.2 Samples Submitted for Visual Screening**

- a) Bidders must submit accurate samples of forms as specified on 4.3.2 (c) for the purpose of visual screening evaluation, and to verify compliance to specification during the evaluation phase. Non-compliance with this requirement will invalidate the bid for the item which samples is not submitted.
- b) Bidders must submit with the sample(s), a completed and signed Sample Submission Form (see Annexure B), indicating which samples have been submitted for visual screening. Upon submitting the samples, bidders must ensure that they obtain a receipt copy as proof of sample submission.

- d) Required samples mentioned in 4.3.2 (c) must be indicated on the sample submission form. Prospective bidders can submit only mandatory forms for the categories of their interest.
- e) All samples offered must be submitted as follows:

- f) Bids which are not supported by mandatory samples submission will invalidate the bid.

#### 4.3.3 Marking of Samples

- a) Samples must be clearly marked with the bid number, item number(s), and the bidder's name. These details must appear on an outer package of the product to make it easier to identify the product.
- b) Samples must be placed in suitable containers and be clearly marked on the outside with the bid number, item number(s), and the bidder's name. This detail must appear on a label attached to each individual item package.
- c) Failure to comply with this condition will invalidate the bid against the relevant item.

#### 4.4. PHASE IV: PRICE AND B-BBEE (80/20 CRITERIA)

##### 4.4.1 Response Field

Bidders are required to submit responsive bids by completing all prices per section of interest that they are bidding for.

##### 4.4.2 Applicable Taxes

All bid prices must be inclusive of all applicable taxes. Failure to comply with this condition will invalidate the bid.

**4.4.3 Value Added Tax**

All bid prices must be inclusive of fifteen percent (15%) Value Added Tax. Failure to comply with this condition will invalidate the bid.

**4.4.4 Pricing Structure**

4.4.4.1 The Pricing Schedule (see Section A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J and K) must be submitted as hardcopy which must be included in the bid document and also the schedule of requirements showing the prices must be included.

4.4.4.2 The SBD3.2 in Section A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J and K will be the hard copy version of the pricing schedule and will be the legal document.

4.4.4.3 The pricing schedule provided in this bid forms an integral part of the bid document and bidders must ensure that it is completed without changing the structure thereof.

4.4.4.4 Prices must include tax and delivery cost to the ordering institution. Prices submitted will be only for the first year, following years will be submitted annually as an addendum for price adjustments, based on the average CPI

4.4.4.5 Price structures that do not comply with the requirements of the above paragraph may invalidate the section of the bid.

**4.4.5 Preferential Point System**

4.4.5.1 In terms of Regulation 7 of the Preferential Procurement Regulations pertaining to the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000 (Act 5 of 2000), responsive bids will be adjudicated by the State on the 80/20 preference point system in terms of which points are awarded to bidders based on:

4.4.5.2 The bid price (Maximum of 80 points)

4.4.5.3 B-BBEE status level of contributor (maximum 20 points)

4.4.5.4 The following formula will be used to calculate the points for price:

$$P_s = 90 \left( \frac{P_t - P_{\min}}{P_{\min}} \right)$$

4.4.5.5 A maximum of 20 points may be allocated to a bidder for attaining their B-BBEE status level of contributor in accordance with the table below:

4.4.5.6 Bidders are required to complete the preference claim form SBD 6.1, and submit their original and valid B-BBEE status level verification certificate or a certified copy thereof or a sworn affidavit at the closing date and time of the bid in order to claim the B-BBEE status level point.

4.4.5.7 The points scored by a bidder in respect of the level of B-BBEE contribution will be added to the points scored for price.

4.4.5.8 Only bidders who have completed and signed the declaration part of the preference claim form and who have submitted a B-BBEE status level certificate issued by an accredited verification agency or a sworn affidavit will be considered for preference points.

4.4.5.9 The State may, before a bid is adjudicated or at any time, require a bidder to substantiate claims it has made with regard to preference.

4.4.5.10 The points scored will be rounded off to the nearest two (2) decimals.

4.4.5.11 In the event that two (2) or more bids have scored equal total points, the award will be to the bidder scoring the highest number of preference points for B-BBEE.

4.4.5.12 However, when functionality is part of the evaluation process and two (2) or more bidders have scored equal points including equal preference points for B-BBEE, the awarded will be to the bidder scoring the highest for functionality.

4.4.5.13 Should two (2) or more bids be equal in all respects, the award shall be decided by the drawing of sections.

4.4.5.14 A contract may, on reasonable and justifiable grounds, be awarded to a bid that did not score the highest number of points.

#### **4.4.6 Multiple Award**

4.4.6.1 The Free State Department of Health reserves the right to award the same item to more than one supplier to address product availability. Due diligence will be applied to ensure that pricing is affordable, market related and aligned to end-user requirements.

4.4.6.2 The maximum number of bidders to be awarded on the same line item will be based on the capacity of the recommended bidders to deliver the required quantities.

## **5 RECOMMENDATION AND APPOINTMENT OF A PANEL OF BIDDERS**

5.1 The Bid Evaluation Committee will recommend a preferred responsive bidder based on the evaluation criteria stipulated above.

5.2 The award of the Contract is subject to meeting all the requirements of the bid.

5.3 The bid will be split between minimum of two suppliers per section, and not more than two sections per supplier.

## **PART 2: ADDITIONAL BID REQUIREMENT**

### **6 Introduction**

All bidders must comply with the requirements below as well as submit all required documents referred below. Unless the requirements specifically provide for mandatory compliance, Free State Department of Health reserves the right to disqualify a bid that does not comply with any of the requirements in clause 5.

## **7 COMPANY PROFILE**

7.1 Bidders are requested to submit company profile which includes, but is not limited, to the following:

- Business structure and strategies; and
- Details of the bidder's directors/owners (Full name and surname and ID or passport number)
- Years of company existence and experience relevant to this bid.

7.2 The company profile must further include a shareholding portfolio with valid proof of registration of the company with CIPC. If by law registration with CIPC is not required, proof of ownership/shareholding must be provided.

7.3 Failure to submit a company profile may invalidate the bid

## **8 TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

No subcontracting agreement between the bidder and any third-party agreements will be binding to the Free State Department of Health.

## **9 COUNTER CONDITIONS**

Bidders' attention is drawn to the fact that amendments to any of the bid conditions or setting of counter conditions by bidders may result in the invalidation of such bids.

## **10 RIGHT OF AWARD**

The Free State Department of Health reserves its following rights:

- Request further technical information from any bidder after the closing date.
- Verify information and documentation of the service provider.
- To withdraw or amend any of the bid conditions by notice in writing to all bidders prior to closing of the bid and post award; and
- In the event that an incorrect award has been made to remedy the matter in any lawful manner it may deem fit.

## **11 NEGOTIATION**

- 11.1 The Department reserves the right to enter into negotiations with bidders (before the contract is concluded) and contractors (after the contract is concluded) regarding inter alia price revisions, increases and service delivery should it be deemed necessary.
- 11.2 The Department reserves the right to negotiate a flat rate amongst the successful bidders should the differences in cost be determined as exorbitant or unfounded

## **12 SUBMISSION OF BIDS**

- 12.1 Bidders must respond to the bid as follows: Submit hard copies at Bophelo House, c/o Charlotte Maxeke Street and Harvey Road, Block C West, Central Business Centre, Bloemfontein, 9300. Deposit the bid in the tender box.
- 12.2 Bidders are requested to initial each page of the bid document on the bottom right hand corner.
- 12.3 Submit any bid queries via email to the contact persons appearing on BID documents
- 12.4 The hard copy of the bid response will serve as the legal bid document.
- 12.5 Bidders must submit the bid to Bid Management in the following format: One (1) original hard copy clearly marked as "original";
- 12.6 A bid should be submitted in a sealed envelope or sealed suitable cover on which the name and address of the bidder, the bid number and the closing date must be clearly visible.

## **13 LATE BIDS**

Bids received after the closing date and time by the Bid Management will NOT be accepted for consideration and where practicable, be returned unopened to the bidder.

## **14 COMMUNICATION AND CONFIDENTIALITY**

- 14.1 The accounting officer may give permission to communicate with bidders where clarity is sought after the closing date and time of the bid and prior to the award of the contract, or to extend the validity period of the bid, if necessary.

- 14.2 If a bidder finds or reasonably believes it has found any discrepancy, ambiguity, error or inconsistency in this bid or any other information provided by the Bid Management (other than minor clerical matters), the bidder must promptly notify the Bid Management in writing of such discrepancy, ambiguity, error or inconsistency in order to afford the Bid Management an opportunity to consider what corrective action is necessary (if any).
- 14.3 Any actual discrepancy, ambiguity, error or inconsistency in this bid or any other information provided by the Bid Management will, if possible, be corrected and provided to all bidders without attribution to the bidder who provided the written notice.
- 14.4 All communication between the bidder and the Bid Management office must be done in writing.

## **15 COPYRIGHT/INTELLECTUAL**

- 15.1 All goods/products and material bearing the logo of Free State Department of Health, should be distributed solely to the Institution of the Free State Department of Health.
- 15.2 Free State Department of Health retains copy right / intellectual property rights on all listed.

## **SECTION B: CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT**

## **16 CONCLUSION OF CONTRACT**

- 16.1 The Contract between Free State Department of Health and the preferred bidder/s (Service Provider) collectively referred to as the Parties shall come into effect after the service provider has been issued with an unconditional letter of acceptance to their bid.
- 16.2 The Service Provider (s) shall be appointed in terms of this bid.
- 16.3 The following will form part of the contract documents between the Parties in as far this Printing contract is concerned:
- i. Bid Documents;
  - ii. Letter of Appointment;
  - iii. Award Documents;
  - iv. Acknowledgement letter
- 16.4 In the event that there is any contradiction between the above-mentioned documents, the special conditions of contract shall take precedent.

16.5 The term "service provider "shall refer to the preferred bidder appointed in terms of Printing contract.

## **17 HANDLING OF SAMPLES AFTER CONTRACT IS AWARDED**

17.1 Samples are required for each H-form bi-annually from suppliers, only if there are changes or newer versions.

17.2 Suppliers must supply the copies of samples to Procurement section at the Free State Medical Depot, 23-25 Blignaut Street, Hilton Bloemfontein with two hard copies of samples as per specification of the H-form. One copy will remain at Free State Medical Depot and one copy in the possession of the supplier after the final proof being signed off.

17.3 On biannual basis (1 May, 1 November) suppliers will be notified via the e-mails if there are changes or new version of the forms.

17.4 Medical Depot will send supersession letter for newer versions to both suppliers and facilities, indicating date for commencement of newer versions.

17.5 The Medical Depot will inform suppliers when to start delivering new versions so as to manage Phase-in of new forms and Phase-out of old forms.

17.6 Medical Depot is the only institution which can make changes to documents and can communicate with the appointed supplier regarding changes

17.7 Final proofs of samples for printing must be proof read and approved by Free State Medical Depot Procurement section.

17.8 Only documents which have the **FINAL APPROVAL** stamp together with the signature of Free State Medical Depot Procurement section will be considered as approved documents.

**17.9 Forms which are printed NOT according to the approved specification and having no approved STAMP will be at the cost of the supplier.**

## **18 AMENDMENTS TO FORMS, LABELS AND IEC MATERIAL**

18.1 Newly designed forms, labels and IEC material which become available during the contract period, normal SCM procedures must be followed by inviting only appointed suppliers as per contract.



18.2 During the period of the contract some of the items may be cancelled or replaced as per need of the department. Appointed supplier will be required to print and deliver items where description / content could differ from the initial bid document but specification will remain the same. Final proofs of samples for printing must be proof read and approved by Free State Medical Depot Procurement section

## **19 PARTICIPATING FREE STATE INSTITUTIONS**

**Provincial Institutions of Health:** Primary Health Care Clinics, Community Health Care Clinics, District Hospitals, Regional Hospitals, Tertiary Hospital, Academic Hospitals, Free State Psychiatric Complex, Free State Medical Depot and all other health institutions of the Free State Department of Health.

## **20 DELIVERY, QUANTITIES AND ORDERS**

### **20.1 Delivery Basis**

- 20.1.1 Delivery of goods must be made in accordance with the instructions including specified delivery points appearing on the official order forms issued by purchasing institutions.
- 20.1.2 Suppliers must deliver complete orders as appearing on the official order form issued and no partial orders / delivery will be accepted by the Free State Department of Health, unless approved by the ordering institution.
- 20.1.3 All deliveries or dispatches must be accompanied by an invoice stating the official order number against which the delivery has been effected.
- 20.1.4 In respect of items awarded to them, suppliers must adhere strictly to the delivery lead times. Lead time for normal orders will be 30 days while the lead time for an emergency order will be 14 days from the date of the order.
- 20.1.5 **Deliveries not complying with the order forms will be returned to the supplier at the supplier's expense.**
- 20.1.6 Transit and storage conditions applicable to relevant product must be adhered to.

- 20.1.7 All deliveries shall be affected within 30 working days after receiving of an official order. Should the supplier not be able to honour this condition, prior arrangement must be made with the relevant institution. The supplier shall ensure the integrity of goods while in transit.
- 20.1.8 Delivery terms will be DAP (Delivery at Place) to the address of ordering institution.
- 20.1.9 The Free State Department of Health reserves the right to negotiate delivery lead times

## **20.2 Quantities**

- 20.2.1 No quantities will be reflected in the bid and no guarantee will be given or implied as to the actual quantity which will be procured during the contract period. *This shall be governed solely by the requirement of the requesting institutions.*
- 20.2.2 The Free State Department of Health reserves the right to negotiate with bidder's adjustment of their minimum order quantities prior to award of the bid.

## **20.3 Orders**

- 20.3.1 All forms labels, information, education and communication material must be folded as per requirements of the form on technical specification.
- 20.3.2 All forms and information, education and communication material must be packed as per technical specifications.
- 20.3.4 Suppliers should note that each individual purchasing institution is responsible for generating the order(s) as well as the payment(s) thereof. In the case whereby institutions make their orders through the Free State Medical Depot, payment will be done by the Free State Medical Depot after the delivery has been affected directly to the facility that ordered.
- 20.3.5 Suppliers should note that the order(s) will be placed as and when required during the contract period and delivery points will be specified by the relevant purchasing institution(s) or stated on the purchase order.
- 20.3.6 The instructions appearing on the official order form regarding the supply, dispatch and submission of invoices must be strictly adhered to and under no circumstances should the Supplier deviate from the orders issued by the purchasing institutions.
- 20.3.7 The Free State Department of Health is under no obligation to accept any quantity which is in excess of the ordered quantity.**

**21 PACKAGING AND LABELLING****21.1 Packaging**

- 21.1.1 All deliveries made against this contract, in all modes of transport, are to be packed in suitable containers.
- 21.1.2 Packaging must be suitable for further dispatch, storage and stacking according to Good Wholesaling Practice and Good Distribution Practice.
- 21.1.3 Packaging must be suitable for transportation and should prevent exposure to conditions that could adversely affect the stability and integrity of the product.
- 21.1.4 The packing must be uniform for the duration of the contract period. All products must be packed in acceptable containers, specifically developed for the product.
- 21.1.5 The number of units in the unit pack (as per Section A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J and K), shelf pack and shipper pack must be completed in the Bid Response Document.
- 21.1.6 Where a particular stacking and storage configuration is recommended by the supplier, this should be clearly illustrated on the outer packaging.
- 21.1.7 Where the contents of the shipper pack represent a standard supply quantity of an item, the following must be adhered to:
- Outer packaging flanges must be sealed with suitable tape that will clearly display evidence of tampering
  - The contents must be packed in neat, uniform rows and columns that will facilitate easy counting when opened.
- 21.1.8 Where the contents of a shipper pack represent a non-standard supply quantity, the following must be adhered to:
- Outer packaging flanges must be sealed with suitable tape that will clearly display evidence of tampering.
  - The shipper pack must contain only one product, mixing of multiple items in a single shipper is not allowed.
- 21.1.9 Suppliers must ensure that products delivered are received in good order at the point of delivery.

## **21.2 Labelling**

21.2.1 All containers, packing and cartons must be clearly labelled.

21.2.2 The following information must be clearly and indelibly printed on all shelf and shipper packs:

- Name of the form, label and IEC
- Number of units in pack

## **22 CONTRACT MANAGEMENT: ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

### **22.1 Contract Administration**

22.1.1 The administration and facilitation of the contract is the responsibility of the Free State Department of Health and all correspondence in this regard must be directed to the Contract Management via email on [KompheleTE@fshealth.gov.za](mailto:KompheleTE@fshealth.gov.za).

22.1.2 Suppliers must advise Contract Management immediately when unforeseeable circumstances will adversely affect the execution of the contract. Full particulars of such circumstances as well as the period of delay must be furnished.

### **22.2 Supplier Performance Management**

22.2.1 Supplier performance management will be the responsibility of the Institutions and where supplier performance disputes cannot be resolved between the service provider and the relevant purchasing institution, Contract Management must be contacted for corrective actions.

22.2.2 Institutions in the Free State Department of Health are required to report to Contract Management on where service provider's performance is not satisfactory.

## **23 POST AWARD MONITORING AND REPORTING**

23.1 Contract Management in Free State Department of Health will conduct meetings annually or when there is an urgent need with the Institutions and Suppliers to discuss contract issues related to Printing Contract.

23.2 Institutions must report to contracts management biannually on the delivery performance, and suppliers must also report biannually on the performance of payments.

## **25 TERMINATION**

The Free State Department of Health shall be entitled to terminate this agreement if one or more of the following occur:

- The service provider decides to transfer the contract or cede the contract;
- The service provider does not honour contractual obligations including submission of information;
- The service provider is provisionally or finally liquidated, making it impossible for the service provider to perform its functions in terms of this Contract;
- The service provider enters into settlement arrangements with their creditors;
- The service provider commits an act of insolvency;
- In the event that the service provider is a member of an unincorporated joint venture or consortium and the membership of such joint venture or Consortium changes.
- There is a change in ownership of the service provider that has the effect that over 50% ownership of the service provider belongs to the new owner without prior written approval of the Free State Department of Health.
- Overall poor performance rating during the contract period
