

## **1. CTT 25898 OFFSHORE SURVIVAL TRAINING**

### **SCOPE OF WORK**

#### **1.1 Background**

Offshore working conditions are hazardous because of the weather conditions like frequent storms and gales, ever-changing currents and tides and dangerous marine ecosystem for human beings. It is therefore crucial that offshore workers gain a basic level of understanding and awareness of the hazards which can be encountered on offshore installations, and the safety management systems in place to control and mitigate those hazards.

#### **1.2 Training**

Delegates will be provided a range of knowledge and skills relevant to travelling offshore by helicopter and working offshore. The training should cover the proper use of emergency equipment and procedures, with the aim to enhance survivability by providing the knowledge, skills and confidence to respond effectively in the event of an offshore emergency.

Training topics to include:

- Safety induction
- Helicopter safety and escape
- Sea survival
- First aid knowledge
- Firefighting and self-rescue

#### **1.3 Assessment**

- a. Theory assessment on key elements of this course.
- b. Practical assessment on key elements of this course.

#### **1.4 Certification**

A certificate is to be issued to a trainee provided a trainee has successfully completed all the key elements of the course and deemed competent.

#### **1.5. Refresher course once validity of certificate expires**

This course will cover the refresher requirements of the original Offshore Survival, Fire Fighting and First Aid Course and be a suitable basic course for personnel who are infrequent visitors to offshore installations.

## **1.6 Acceptable Accreditation**

- a. International Association for Safety and Survival Training (IASST).

## **1.7 Exemption**

Supplier to have a system in place for the exemption of valid First Aid and Fire Fighting certificates issued by other Institutions as well as PetroSA.

### **Note:**

- The Supplier will provide the Services on an as and when required basis.
- No services shall be performed without a Work Order/Purchase Order issued by PetroSA's Offshore Engineer. No invoice will be paid without the corresponding Purchase Order number appearing on the invoice.
- The training shall be provided at the premises of the Supplier.
