Swartland Municipality invites tenders for the supply of **COMMUNITY BASED COLLECTION OF GENERAL SOLID WASTE AT CHATSWORTH, RIVERLANDS AND KALBASKRAAL** in the Swartland Municipal Area, Western Cape.

A non-refundable cash fee of **R160.00** is payable to Swartland Municipality for collection of **hard copy** tender documents. The fee is payable at the cashier offices at the Municipal offices in Kerk Street Malmesbury. Only cash will be accepted. No electronic transfers will be accepted. The tender document is available in electronic format on request, at no charge, from vanderWesthuizenJ@swartland.org.za.

A compulsory clarification meeting will be held on 22 January 2024 at 11:00 at the Banquet Hall, Municipal Head Offices, on the corner of Kerk- and Voortrekker Streets, Malmesbury.

Tenders and all relevant documentation must be submitted in a sealed envelope, clearly marked "Formal Tender T07.23.24 – COMMUNITY BASED COLLECTION OF GENERAL SOLID WASTE AT CHATSWORTH, RIVERLANDS AND KALBASKRAAL FOR THE PERIOD ENDING 30 JUNE 2026", together with the name and contact details of bidder on the envelope. Envelopes must be deposited in the tender box at the Municipal Head Offices, on the cnr of Kerk and Voortrekker Streets, Malmesbury, before 12h00 on Friday 16 February 2024. Envelopes without the required information will be regarded as non-conforming and will be rejected. **No late quotations, electronic or faxed tenders will be accepted.**

Bids will be evaluated in accordance with the Council's Preferential Procurement Policy and the attached specifications. The 80/20-preference point system will be used for the evaluation of the contract. The Preferential Procurement Policy will be available for perusal during normal office hours at the municipal offices. The Swartland Municipality endorses and supports the Government's Black Economic Empowerment Programme and is committed to rectify the inequalities of the past. For bidders to qualify for the advantages of the B-BBEE Act, they must thoroughly complete the attached Annexure MBD 6.1. **There will be no benefits if the schedule is not thoroughly completed. Preference points MUST also be claimed in paragraph 6.1.** Bidders are required to submit **original and valid B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificates or certified copies** thereof together with their bids, to substantiate their B-BBEE rating claims. **Bidders are also required to submit Proof of Locality in order to claim points for locality.** This Bid is subject to the General Conditions of Tender and if applicable, any other Special Conditions of Tender.

All **technical enquiries received by that time will be answered and corresponded to all prospective tenderers by no later than 16:00 on 9 February 2024.**
