BACKGROUND: The Climatic room of the SAAPPA glasshouse is used by the breeding programmes for inoculations of seedlings for disease resistance trails. The room is equipped to control temperatures, wetness and humidity that is needed for successful disease inoculations. The room is also used for student trails and this needs to be done on specific times of the season.

PURPOSE : The Climatic room is currently broken and is in need for repair. Urgent inoculation trails need to be conducted in the next few months.
