


Questions	Answers
<p>1. As part of the criteria for the abovementioned bid, Tenders are to provide proof of DESD training certificate and environmental Law course certificate. The closing date for the tender is 23.04.2024, where can one find these 2 courses and obtain the training / certificates ?</p>	<p>Refer to Addendum 1 in the Tender portals, for upcoming Environmental Law and DESD training.</p>
<p>2. I would like to inquire about the above mentioned project on Section 2 – Technical - ANNEX A – POWERLINE SURVEY EXPERIENCE TEMPLATE , what do we write on the Resource Name?</p>	<p>The name of the Qualified Professional .</p>
<p>3. On The Supplier Evaluation Pack: PAYE Questionnaire for Service Contracts to Eskom Group of Companies Document: Question 2(iii) speaks about signing a document at the end of the Evaluation Pack named “Particulars of persons acting as representative of the Company/Close Corporation/Trust” We have searched for this section in the entire document and have not found it, please can you see if this has portion of the document has been erroneously omitted or direct us to where we can find it.</p>	<p>The information is on page 11 on the PAYE Questionnaire for Service Contracts to Eskom Group of Companies Document:</p> 
<p>4. I need to inquire for example on form SBD 1, page 36, where the space to write the full description of the tender is very small, can I write “SURVEY PANEL CONTRACT CENTRAL EAST CLUSTER” instead of the full description: “The establishment of an enabling agreement for 50 Service providers for the Provision of Engineering, Cadastral Surveys and Pre-marketing Services in respect of High Voltage, Low Voltage, Medium Voltage line and Cable surveys within Central East Cluster (Kwa-Zulu Natal and Free State), on an “as and when” required basis for a period of thirty-six (36) months”, which does not fit.</p>	<p>Yes, you can write SURVEY PANEL CONTRACT CENTRAL EAST CLUSTER.</p>

<p>Will I be disqualified if I do that?</p>	<p>You will not be disqualified by not writing the full description.</p>
<p>5. I have a question on the Nec_3_professional services contract, when it comes to pricing there are basic charges for the creation of land rights, are we expected to give prices for that as well?</p>	<p>No, you are not expected to give prices.</p>
<p>6. Item 3.5 on the “KZN129_ Invitation to tender Survey panel contract” say “The standard rates will be proposed to the successful service provider prior contract award.” However we also see C2.2 Staff rates, expenses & the task schedule that looks like we have to put in rates. Enquiry: Please clarify if we need to put in our rates or we leave blank for the proposed rates by eskom.</p>	<p>Leave blank C2.2 in the NEC3. The standard rates will be proposed to the successful service provider prior contract award.</p>
<p>7. I have a few questions regarding the Environmental law section of the tender: Will it be accepted if we complete an environmental law course outside of KZN? Will it be accepted if we complete an environmental law course not presented by Eskom? Will you only accept it if we complete the environmental course if Eskom presents it?</p>	<p>External Environmental law training will be accepted.</p>
<p>8. Please can you clarify how you want the tender documents to be bound. Do you want it as one complete unit with all six sections or each section bound individual Do you want it punched or bound with the black sticky tape?</p>	<p>It recommended that each section be bounded individually. Bounded with the black sticky tape is preferred. Punched document may be removed/fallen off.</p>
<p>9. Kindly advise if DESD training is a compulsory requirement for this tender. We have in-house Environmental Assessment Practitioners registered with EAPASA.</p>	<p>DESD training is one of the required training and carries a score on the technical criteria. A supplier without DESD trained resource/s will not be disqualified but will be marked down when scoring.</p>
<p>10. The invitation to tender document on page 9 , par 3.15 it states that ‘ The standard rates will be proposed to the successful service provider prior contract award.’ . Reading from this statement , should we then skip(Not fill out) C2.2 in the NEC3 contract</p>	<p>Leave blank C2.2 in the NEC3. The standard rates will be proposed to the successful service provider prior contract award.</p>

<p>11. Please assist me here, Three of us own companies that are eligible tenderers based in East London, Eastern Cape.</p> <p>We have all performed work for the ECOU of Eskom since about 2005.</p> <p>We have all completed the DESD & Environmental LAW training / certifications back in 2019.</p> <p>None of our certificates have expiry dates on them.!</p> <p>Will these suffice for the tender KZN129 as we see that the tender submission deadline has been moved to the 7th of May to accommodate training for these certificates etc.</p> <p>Please advise?</p>	<p>DESD & Environmental LAW training certificates obtained in 2019 ECOU will suffice but its recommended that suppliers attend KZN specific training where possible.</p>
