SCOPE OF WORK

1. Objective

The objective of this bid is to appoint a suitably qualified service provider to review the Business Continuity programme at SAT assist with the implementation of the BCPs and conduct the simulation exercise.

2. Background

Following the completed Business Continuity Management (BCM) project in 2022 and the current BCM programme maturity, SAT has elected to improve its crisis response readiness by conducting a BCM simulation exercise. The exercise will focus, first, on improving the awareness and preparedness of the members of our Crisis Management Team (CMT) to effectively address a crisis. SAT requires the services of experienced and skilled service provider to facilitate such a complex and advanced exercise (simulation exercise) on behalf of SAT.

3. Scope of Work

- 3.1 The scope of work defines the deliverables to be provided by the successful Bidder for a period of 6 (six months), with the simulation exercise testing planned for Q4. The objective of the appointment is to assist SAT in reviewing and enhancing BCM capability and conduct workshops with each business unit to determine readiness to implement BPCs. The engagement will be in accordance with international standards and best practices for BCM. The ultimate objective will be to prepare for the testing of the BCPs and simulation exercise that will contribute to the overall resilience of the organisation's business operations to significant disruptions or disasters. The scope of work will include the following key activities:
 - Review the Business Continuity Management Programme concluded in 2022;
 - To identify opportunities to improve BCMS and associated responses to a major disruption.
 - To improve responses, processes, and the skills required to reach a mature state of managing a disruptive event.
 - To familiarise and rehearse the SAT response to a crisis with the CMT.
 - To provide high-level BCM awareness training for all participants in the simulation exercise.
 - To identify additional documents required to support the crisis management plan (CMP).
 - To validate the CMT's role and plan during a crisis.
 - To build confidence that if SAT is faced with a disruptive event all role players are comfortable with their responsibilities.
 - To build efficiencies regarding communication, interaction, and escalation during a crisis.
 - Cost the BCPs alternative solutions to enable SAT management to make informed decisions on the most appropriate recovery solutions.
 - Assist in the implementation of the BCPs; and
 - Conduct simulation exercise testing.

The above will have to be implemented in line with the SAT BCM Policy and Framework which are aligned to ISO22301: 2012 - Business continuity management systems and The BCI Good Practice

Guidelines.
