Tender documents will be made available from the date of advertisement at the offices of Civil Engineering Services Directorate, Old Town Hall, 90 York Street. Entrance to the venue is in York Street. Tenderers are required to arrange for collection of the tender documents at least two (2) working days in advance. A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the Employer will be held at The Old Town Hall, 90 York Street, George at 10:00 on 14 August 2026.

Note: There will be an attendance register for the compulsory clarification meeting which needs to be signed.

The Municipality would advise that the representative be a technical person as the clarification meeting will contain technical considerations.

The certificate of attendance will only be signed after the clarification meeting.

Prospective bidders that arrive after 15 (fifteen) minutes of the advertised time, will not be allowed to attend the meeting or to sign the attendance register, unless the person chairing the meeting gives permission to do so. Reasons for the chairperson's decision must be duly noted.

Tenders will be evaluated and awarded as follows:

Stage 1: Eligibility Criteria

- Attendance of the compulsory tender clarification meeting.
- Bidder must be an Authorized System Integrator of the Adroit SCADA software
- Bidders must furnish proof of qualification in the form of a training certificate to work on the SCADA OPC driver interface utilised in the existing system. This certificate must be issued in the name of the bidder OR in the name of the proposed programmer who is currently employed by the bidder, if not then a letter stating such intent to employ this person, including this person's signature of willingness & acceptance for the intended duration of the project.

Stage 2: Functionality

Only Tenders scoring a minimum of **70** out of **100** will be further evaluated in terms of Stage 3: Price and Preference.

Stage 3: Price, Preference and Specific Goals

Tenders will be evaluated and adjudicated in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (Act 5 of 2000) Regulations 2022; the George Municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy as well as the George Municipality's Preferential procurement Policy, where **80** points will be scored for price and **20** points for B-BBEE status and specific goals. Refer to the Tender Data for detailed breakdown of the evaluation process.

The Municipality reserves the right to withdraw any Invitation to Tender and/or to re-advertise or to reject any tender or to accept a part of it. The Municipality is not bound to accept the lowest or any tender.

A valid SARS Tax Compliance Status (TCS) PIN must be submitted with the tender.

It will be required from the successful Bidder to register on the Central Supplier Database (CSD).
