- award only a portion of the proposed goods / services which are reflected in the scope of this RFQ;

10 Legal review

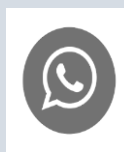

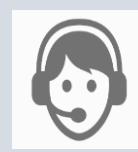

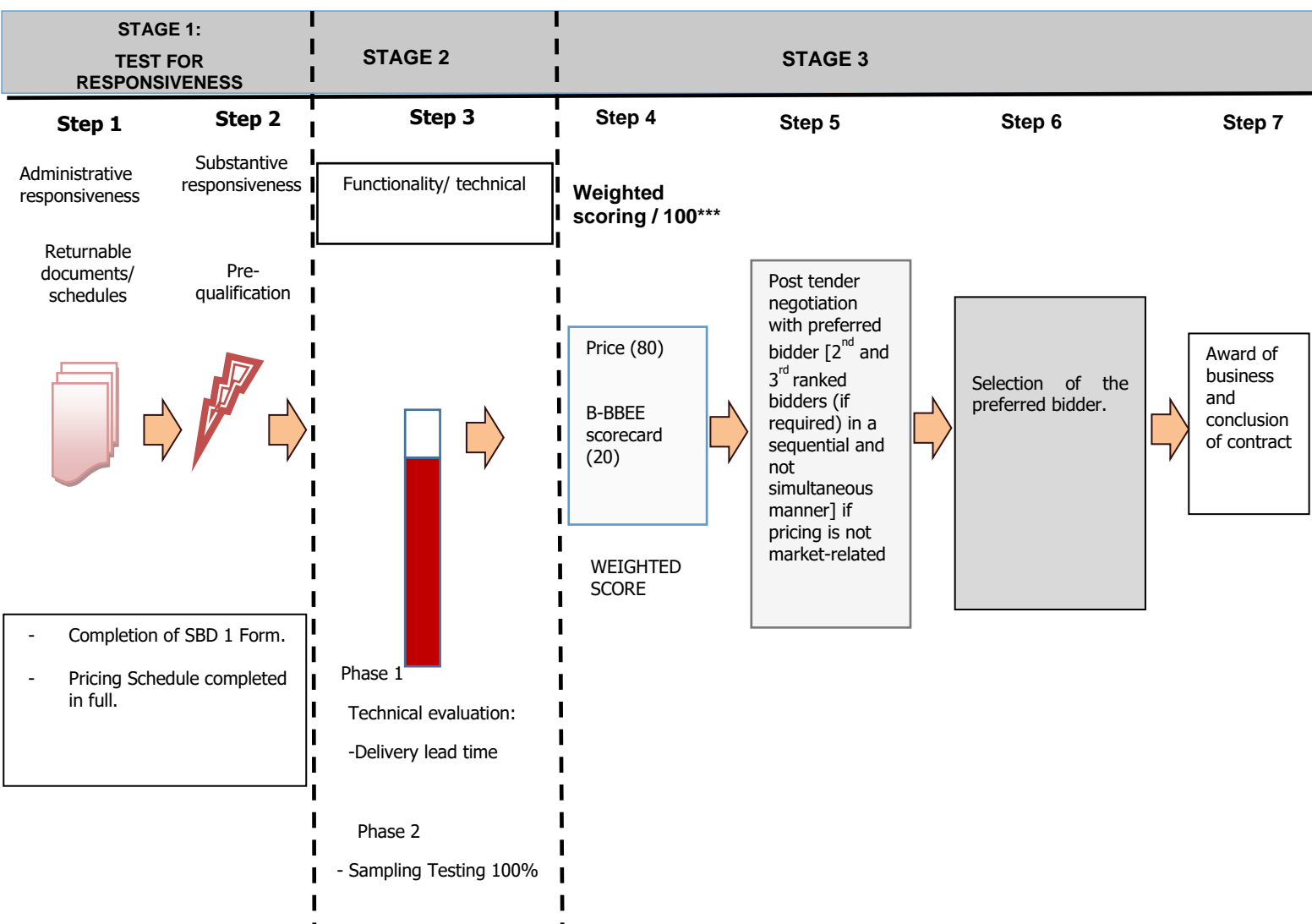
