Tender Documents must be placed in the Municipal tender box, Supply Chain Management Unit, 26 Church Street, Oudtshoorn, no later than 02 June 2026, and will be opened in public immediately after tender closing. 4. Tenders may only be submitted on the Tender documentation issued by the Municipality. 5. The Oudtshoorn Municipality does not bind itself to accept any tender that is not compliant and reserves the right to accept any tender, as it may deem expedient. 6. Tenderers who are not yet registered are required to register on the Municipality's Accredited Supplier Database (CSD). Application forms are obtainable from the website https://secure.csd.gov.za. 7. Tenderers will be required to submit three (3) years' most recent audited financial statements, and or since the date of establishment if established during the past three years. 8. Tenderers will be required to have a specified level of experience to be eligible to tender.

Functionality and Preferential Procurement

Detailed requirements are contained in the tender document.

Bidders must demonstrate experience by submitting at least three (3) completed water reticulation projects (minimum 3,000 m of ≥ 75 mm diameter pipeline) and three (3) completed sewer projects (minimum 2,000 m of ≥ 160 mm diameter gravity sewer). Projects may be combined, provided both components meet the minimum requirements. Each project must be supported by a completion certificate and a completed reference letter (pro forma provided).

Functionality will be applied on a pass/fail basis only, and only compliant bidders will be placed on the panel.

As and when funds become available, RFQs will be issued to panel members, at which stage detailed scopes and BOQs will be provided.
