1. Background Overview

1.1 The KZN Liquor Authority

The KwaZulu-Natal Liquor Authority currently regulates liquor licensing and control of the liquor industry through the provisions of the KwaZulu-Natal, Act 06 of 2010 as amended. Since the enactment of the Constitution of South Africa, (No. 108 of 1996), the mandate to legislate on retail and micro-manufacturing liquor licensing is the exclusive legislative competence of provinces.

The Liquor Authority is registered as a Schedule 3C Public Entity in terms of the Public Finance Management Act. The KZN Liquor Licencing Act 06 of 2010 sets out objectives that the provincial strives to achieve with regard to retail liquor licencing and micro manufacturing. It also extends beyond the process of licensing and includes objectives of balancing the congruent objectives of providing a stable social environment against promoting the growth of the liquor industry.
