1.	We are preparing our submission for Tender E3264DXKZNOU (Detailed Aerial Inspection Services). We would like to request clarification on the technical criteria. The tender guidelines state that a previous aerial inspection report not less than 24 months old must be submitted. Please clarify the following regarding this requirement: Drone Reports Eligibility: Over the past 24 months, our aerial inspection operations for powerline/network environments have been executed primarily using unmanned drones rather than manned helicopters. Will a detailed aerial inspection report generated from our drone operations over the last 24 months satisfy this technical criterion?	The use of unmanned drones will not be permitted for this tender.	28.07.2026

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
