

SDL & I Programme for the purposes of CIDB Requirements for Ash and Coal Procurement Strategy

Note that one of the tender requirements is a tenderer with CIDB Grade 9 ME or 8 ME PE. In terms of CIDB Regulations, *“Where employers have in place a targeted development programme, contractors who are registered PE may be awarded a contract in one contractor grading designation higher than their current contractor grading designation provided that the Employer:*

- *is satisfied that the contractor has the potential to develop into and qualify for registration in a higher grade.*
- *ensures that financial, management or other support is provided to that contractor to enable the contractor to successfully execute the contract.”*

SD&L has therefore made the following provisions Potentially Emerging (PE):

In an event that a potentially emerging contractor becomes a successful bidder the following will have to be considered:

- Project/s successfully completed over the last two financial years.
- The best annual turnover of the last two financial years
- The potential of the contractor to develop and qualify to be registered to the higher grading.
- In ensuring that the contractor execute the work successfully, the following will have to be explored:

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
