  attention is drawn to Form MBD 6.1 whereby bidders other than EMEs must submit their original and valid B-BBEE
  Status level verification certificate or certified copy thereof, substantiating B-BBEE rating issued by a Registered
  Auditor approved IRBA or a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS, EMEs must submit a sworn affidavit. Failure to
  do so will result in zero points score for BBBEE status level;
- In evaluating of the bid prices, the municipality will apply its mind to determine the reasonable bid amounts that are within range with the estimated tender value
