The Tourism Sentiments Analysis sub-system will be developed in a phased-in approach with the intention to have a fully developed system that will enable the department to have a national tourism sentiments analysis platform, that will provide critical data intelligence regarding both the supply and demand side tourism sentiments in South Africa to improve service delivery and future plans.		
	2. PURPOSE OF DOCUMENT		
	The purpose of this document is to appoint a suitable and multi-technology skilled service provider to develop a portal that will be used by job seekers, tourism learners, and Department executives to view tourism sentiments.		
	3. OBJECTIVES OF THE PORTAL		
	The main objectives of the Portal are:		
	 to create a platform for job seekers to get access to tourism and related employment opportunities; to enable tourism businesses to recruit qualified and trained job seekers from a centralised platform; 		
	 to track previously trained youth and learners by the department and establish whether they are employed or unemployed; 	,	
	 to create a centralised national database for job seekers across the tourism value chain; 		
	 to establish a needs-based national database of training opportunities that are required by youth, learners, etc in the tourism sector; 		
	 to present job seekers in tourism with human development opportunities that are provided by various stakeholders.

- Provide bi-weekly and quarterly progress reports.
