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1. BACKGROUND

TASEZ Zone Operation has an electrical apparatus that needs to be maintained as a mandatory regulation. Maintenance covers the planned maintenance (predictive, preventative and RCM) and unplanned maintenance (emergency and breakdown). Electricity maintenance involves proactive measures to ensure the longevity and reliability of electrical systems. Proper and regular maintenance can significantly reduce the risk of electrical failures and even extend the lifespan of equipment/apparatus. It is of paramount practice for Tasez to give our electrical systems a health check-up to prevent unexpected breakdowns and costly repairs.

2. INIVITATION TO SUBMIT A QUOTATION

2.1. This Request for a Quotation (RFQ) is for the appointment of a suitable and experienced service provider to perform once-off preventive maintenance and repairs on the LV Switchgears at 6 of TASEZ's facilities.

3. SCOPE OF WORK

TASEZ wishes to appoint a competent service provider to proceed with the annual maintenance of the LV Switchgear Panels.

The maintenance should focus on cleaning, visual inspections and testing to ensure all components function accordingly and are free from damage or corrosion. Consisting of but not limited to:

Cleaning

- Clean equipment
- Clean switchboard, circuit breakers, inlets and panel boards
- Clean mechanisms, and the surroundings

Testing

- Test all components (e.g. cable, circuit breakers, busbars, etc.)
- Check protection relays
- Check KWh, KVA, and kVAh Demand

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Visual Inspection

• Check for physical damage

- Inspection of busbar and structures
- Examine connections
- Verify earthing

The safety protocols shall be considered and the manufacturer manuals for specific instructions. The service shall cover the repairs in accordance with the OEM for the damage discovered.

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4.2. Clarification questions from bidders will be closed two (2) days before date of closure on the RFQ.

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- 4.3. Any communication to an official in respect of the RFQ between the closing date and the award of the contract by the Bidders is prohibited.
- 4.4. If a Bidders finds or reasonably believes it has found any discrepancy, ambiguity, error or inconsistency in this RFQ or any other information provided by TASEZ (other than minor clerical matters), the Bidders must promptly notify TASEZ in writing of such discrepancy, ambiguity, error or inconsistency in order to afford TASEZ an opportunity to consider what corrective action is necessary (if any).
- 4.5. Any actual discrepancy, ambiguity, error, or inconsistency in the RFQ or any other information provided by TASEZ will, if possible, be corrected and provided to all Bidders without attribution to the Bidders who provided the written notice.
- 4.6. All people (including Bidders) obtaining or receiving the RFQ and any other information in connection with the RFQ must keep the contents of the RFQ and other such information confidential and not disclose or use the information except as required for the purpose of developing a response to the RFQ.

5. LATE SUBMISSION

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- 5.1. Late responses to the RFQ will not be accepted.

DECLARATION CERTIFICATE FOR LOCAL PRODUCTION AND CONTENT FOR DESIGNATED SECTORS

This Standard Bidding Document (SBD) must form part of all bids invited. It contains general information and serves as a declaration form for local content (local production and local content are used interchangeably).

Before completing this declaration, Bidder must study the General Conditions, Definitions, Directives applicable in respect of Local Content as prescribed in the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011, the South African Bureau of Standards (SABS) approved technical specification number SATS 1286:2011 (Edition 1) and the Guidance on the Calculation of Local Content together with the Local Content Declaration Templates [Annex C (Local Content Declaration: Summary Schedule), D

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(Imported Content Declaration: Supporting Schedule to Annex C) and E (Local Content Declaration: Supporting Schedule to Annex C)].

1. General Conditions

- 1.1. Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011 (Regulation 9) makes provision for the promotion of local production and content.
- 1.2. Regulation 9. (1) prescribes that in the case of designated sectors, where in the award of bids local production and content is of critical importance, such bids must be advertised with the specific bidding condition that only locally produced goods, services or works or locally manufactured goods, with a stipulated minimum threshold for local production and content will be considered.
- 1.3. Where necessary, for bids referred to in paragraph 1.2 above, a two-stage bidding process may be followed, where the first stage involves a minimum threshold for local production and content and the second stage price and B-BBEE.

1.6. A bid may be disqualified if -

- 1.6.1. this Declaration Certificate and the Annex C (Local Content Declaration: Summary Schedule) are not submitted as part of the bid documentation; and
- 1.6.2. the bidder fails to declare that the Local Content Declaration Templates (Annex C, D and E) have been audited and certified as correct.

2. Definitions

- 2.1. "bid" includes written price quotations, advertised competitive bids or proposals;
- 2.2. "bid price" price offered by the bidder, excluding value added tax (VAT);
- 2.3. "contract" means the agreement that results from the acceptance of a bid by an organ of state;
