A CALL FOR EMERGING CONTRACTORS TO BID TO BE ON A PRE-APPROVED PANEL OF THE IDT CONTRACTOR DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME IN THE EIGHT PROVINCES OF SOUTH AFRICA FOR A PERIOD OF 36 MONTHS

The Independent Development Trust (IDT) invites suitably qualified contractors in the eight (8) provinces (Eastern Cape, Free State, Gauteng, Limpopo, KZN, North West, Northern Cape, and Western Cape) of South Africa (SA) to bid to be placed in the IDT pre-approved panels of Contractor Development Programme (CDP) for a period of 36 months.

T1.2 MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

Only bidders, who meet the following requirements will be eligible for further evaluation

- Proof of CIDB registration - Grade 1 to 5 GB
- Complete of SBD forms:

 - SBD 4 Declaration of Interest
- Proof of business address; e.g. Municipal Bill, Rental Agreement, proof of ownership etc;
- Proof of Central Supplier Database (CSD) registration
- For Military Veterans must have a certificate or letter with a force number from the Department of Military Veterans and
- A completed affidavit (template provided) for the two nominated members of the entity who undertake the full commitment to the CDP; and

Only bidders who are competent in the advertised work and who have achieved the minimum functionality threshold will be eligible to be part of the panel of CDP Contractors, where functionality will be evaluated further.
