STAGE 1: ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

In order to be considered for this bid, tenderers must meet the following mandatory requirements in order to be considered for this bid:

1. Authority to Sign the Bid Document and all Annexures (see bid document).
2. Valid proof of address of the training facility in the name of the training service provider
3. Valid Accreditation Certificate of the company with the relevant SETA
4. Valid Accreditation certificate of the trainer with the relevant SETA.
5. Valid Accreditation certificate of the Assessor with the relevant SETA
6. Valid Accreditation certificate of the Moderator with the relevant SETA
7. Proof of Central Supplier Database (CSD) registration
8. Submission of fully completed and signed Invitation to Bid (SBD 1)
9. Submission of fully completed and signed Bidder's Disclosure (SBD 4)
10. Submission of fully completed and signed Bidder's Price (SBD 6.1)
11. The following returnable documents shall be submitted together with the bid. The validity of this documentation will be verified at the time of award.
12. 1.7.1 Valid COIDA Certificate/ COIDA Compliance
13. 1.7.2 Full Report of Central Supplier Database
14. Valid Tax Compliance Letter with a unique pin
15. 1.7.4 Proof of office address (proof of ownership or lease agreement or municipal services bill). Municipal bill not more than three (3) months. The office must be based in the respective province.
16. Proof of residence (proof of ownership or lease contract or municipal services bill) The Bid Document must be completed using hand and black permanent ink only.

Only bidders who passed all the above mandatory requirements will be considered for functionality evaluation stage.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

Bidder will be evaluated on functionality as follows:

This bid will be evaluated in two stages
1.8.1. Mandatory and administrative Requirements
1.8.2. Price

Only bidders who obtained minimum of 80% under functionality evaluation will be considered for price and preferential points evaluation.

PRICE AND SPECIFIC GOALS EVALUATION

The 80/20/ and 90/10 of Preferential Point System will be applied, where 80/90 points will be allocated for price and 20/10 points for Specific Goals Status. In order to Claim and be awarded Specific Goals points bidders must submit evidence as stipulated under SBD 6.1 in the bid document. The IDT will appoint bidders in to the framework agreement who met 80% functionality thresholds and offered market related prices in line with Market analysis and historical expenditure conducted by the IDT. The IDT may enter in to negotiations with bidders who offered prices outside market related prices during the evaluation process.
