

Environmental Requirements for the Sale of Zebras and Blesboks at Duvha Power Station.

<p>The buyer must have in their possession the permit to transport live game and must submit a certified copy of the permit to Duvha Power Station before the transportation of the game.</p>	<p>Buyer needs to meet the requirements during the evaluation stage</p>
<p>When transporting the animals to another province, an export/ transport permit is required and must be obtained from the Mpumalanga Parks & Tourism Agency, and the buyer must ensure that a receiving province's conservation permit is obtained.</p>	<p>Buyer needs to meet the requirements during the evaluation stage</p>
<p>The buyer must submit a method statement of capturing, loading, and transportation of the animals. The buyer shall give a full description of the method of capture and type of vehicle that will be used for transportation. The Capturing method shall be as humane as possible.</p>	<p>Buyer needs to meet the requirements during the evaluation stage</p>
<p>For any intention to keep the live game, the buyer shall prove that they have a safe area where they will be keeping the animals and with space that is enough for animals to forage.</p>	<p>Buyer needs to meet the requirements during the evaluation stage</p>
<p>The buyer shall ensure that veterinary facilitation will be made available for the animals and submit proof upon awarding of the tender.</p>	<p>Buyer needs to meet the requirements during the evaluation stage</p>
<p>For any intention to keep the game or wild animals for commercial purposes, the buyer shall submit proof of possession of a game dealer's license issued by the board.</p>	<p>Buyer needs to meet the requirements during the evaluation stage</p>
<p>All Vehicles and trailers transporting the wild animals shall be roadworthy and accommodating for the animals in the following manner:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The trailer must be roadworthy and purpose-built for animal transportation • The trailer must have non-slip flooring (rubberized, battens, or steel grids to prevent falls) • No sharp edges or protrusions to prevent injuries • Adequate ventilation at all time • Trailers must not be fully enclosed • Trailers must provide protection against heat and sun, rain and wind, and exhaust fumes • Space must be able to prevent overcrowding and all animals to stand naturally and have balance during movement • Space must allow animals to lie down comfortably • Side walls must be high enough to prevent escape or falling 	<p>For noting</p>
