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Comment on safety and utility for operational categories of Lifeguard uniform:

Prospective Suppliers are urged to consider that the lifeguards working environment, is physically intense and that they are exposed to varying weather conditions on a daily basis, heat, saltwater, wind, and sand are commonplace.

In ensuring rapid response to emergencies, it is usual for lifeguards to dive in with their shorts and t-shirts during a rescue.

Care and durability are factors that are considered critical in ensuring that lifeguard uniforms last longer and maintain their appearance whether due to repeated washing, staining, and perspiration, etc. In consideration of the work environment, durability also refers to the ability of the garments retaining their integrity under extreme weather conditions and its elements such as; direct heat and sun rays, cold, sea salt, water/being wet, and physical work that will require constant bending, running, swimming and sitting on sand. Colour fastness and appearance is also just as relevant as lifeguards work in a uniformed work environment which will require constant laundering of uniforms. As the personal issuing of uniform is strictly controlled; it is expected that colour fastness and reasonable resistance to fading will assist in ensuring that uniforms last longer.

Special conditions

- **1.** All clothing required be UV Protective.
- 2. Each item must be separately priced, and items and quantities are not guaranteed. Note that only bidders who quote on all uniform items shall be considered for evaluation as only one service provider is preferred for delivery of these items

Evaluation

For purposes of evaluation the Municipality will look at the grand total of both the lifeguard and the shark spotter uniforms indicated in the pricing schedule, but items will be ordered individually as and when required
