T1.1 Tender Notice and Invitation to Tender

The CITY OF CAPE TOWN, URBAN MOBILITY DIRECTORATE, Roads Infrastructure Management Department, invites tenders for Tender No. 113Q/2023/24: REHABILITATION OF JAKES GERWEL DRIVE, NORTH- AND SOUTHBOUND CARRIAGEWAYS, BETWEEN VIKING WAY AND VOORTREKKER ROAD AND SERVICE ROADS.

Tenderers must be registered on Supplier Databases as described in the tender conditions.

Tenderers who are not registered on these Supplier Databases are not precluded from submitting tenders, but must however be registered upon being requested to do so in writing and within the period contained in such a request.

It is estimated that tenderers must have a CIDB contractor grading designation of 8CE or higher.

Preferences are offered to tenderers who tender in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations and the City of Cape Town's Supply Chain Management Policy (SCM Policy). Furthermore, in terms of these Regulations, tenderers are required to meet the HDI and/or RDP specific goals.

Documents may be collected during working hours between 08:30 – 15:00 from **17 November 2013**.

A non-refundable tender fee of R300.00 payable by EFT or cash in favour of the City of Cape Town, is required on collection of the tender documents.

A non-compulsory, but strongly recommended clarification meeting with representatives of the Employer will take place via an online platform (Skype) on **4 December 2013** starting at 12:00.

The closing time for receipt of tenders is **10:00** on **31 January 2024**.

Telegraphic, telephonic, telex, facsimile, e-mail and late tenders will not be accepted.

Tenders may only be submitted on the tender documents that have been issued. Printed Bills of Quantities, in the same format (that is, layout, billed items and quantities) as those issued electronically by the Employer upon request, may be submitted as stated in the Tender Data.

Requirements for sealing, addressing, delivery, opening and assessment of tenders are stated in the Tender Data.
