C.2 INTRODUCTION AND TERMS OF REFERENCE

KZN Growth Fund Trust (KGFT) was set up in 2008 as an initiate of the KZN Government's Department of Economic Development, Tourism and Environmental Affairs (EDTEA) to administer a unique public private partnership that would unlock funding gaps in transitions that would create jobs, enable and promote BBEE participation in business and growth in the economy.

Vision

To be KZN's leading development financier and impact investor.

Mission

To provide competitive and innovative financing solutions to private sector investments that propel socio-economic growth for a better future.

Values

Respect, accountability, integrity, stewardship and entrepreneurship.

Procurement Philosophy

It is the policy of KGFT, when purchasing goods and obtaining services, to follow a course of optimum value and efficiency by adopting best purchasing practices in supply chain management, ensuring that open and fair competition has prevailed, with due regard being given to the importance of:

- a) The promotion, development and support of businesses from disadvantaged communities (small, medium, micro enterprises, as well as established businesses within those communities) in terms of its B-BBEE Policy.
- b) The promotion of national and regional local service providers and agents before considering overseas service providers; and;

1. SCOPE OF WORK

The KGFT wishes to establish a Transaction Advisory panel (TAP) that will serve as the primary database for potential and existing investments. The appointed Bidders will be expected to provide Transaction Advisory Services (TAS) in relation to a range of matters, as determined by activities in the KGFT's Risk and Investment Units. The term (duration) of the Panel (TAP) will be three years.

The KGFT will require the service provider to negotiate the relevant aspects of the transaction on its behalf (in consultation with the appropriate KGFT staff members). The transaction advisory activities are expected to assist the KGFT in making informed decisions.

The service provider is expected to scope the transaction with the KGFT and release an interim report on the required deadlines. A presentation to the KGFT Investment Committee may also be required

Therefore, suitably qualified and experienced service providers are invited to make proposals to the KGFT on their ability to provide Transaction Advisory Services (TAS) to pursue the KGFT's investment decisions. In the conduct of its TAS, the KGFT follows a risk-based approach in that each potential investment has a risk profile that may be significantly different from the next and that may require an approach tailored to fit the characteristics of the relevant investment opportunity. The KGFT expects that as a minimum, each of the conducted TAS must cover the following focus areas:

- Institutional Module
- Management Module
- Marketing and Sales Module
- Technical Module
- Financial Module
 - business modelling, Mergers & Acquisitions (transaction support), and valuations
 - Restructuring
 - Exit strategies/ Divestitures
 - o Commercial and Operational due diligence (Viability assessments);
 - → Best Practice Financial Modelling
 - o Tax
- Legal and Regulatory Module
- Lead Advisory (Sourcing of buyers etc.)
- Environmental, Health and Safety, Business Integrity Module -ESG
- Information Technology Module
- Creating and managing a data room
- Coordinating due diligence process
- Risk analysis including Risk Matrix and Risk Mitigant's

The service provider must be able to demonstrate experience in a minimum of five of the above modules, with more weight tilted towards the Financial Module. Any submission lesser than that will not be considered.
