Part 1

Conditions of Bid

1. BACKGROUND AND INTRODUCTORY PROVISIONS

Refer to Part 2 of this invitation to bid for background and introductory information relating to the Services and this invitation to bid.

2. OFFER AND SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- 2.1 Without detracting from the generality of clause below, bidders must submit a completed and signed and requisite bid forms attached as <u>Part 3</u> with its bid. Bidders must take careful note of the conditions of award.
- 2.2 All bids submitted in reply to this invitation to bid should incorporate all the forms, parts, certificates and other documentation forming part of this invitation to bid, duly completed where required.
- 2.3 It is a requirement that Tax matters of a service provider must be complaint with SARS when submitting, during and at the award of this tender.
- 2.4 In the event that any form or certificate provided in <u>Part 3</u> of this invitation to bid does not have adequate space for the bidder to provide the requested details, the bidder should attach an annexure to such form or certificate on which the requested details should be provided and the bidder should refer to such annexure in the form or certificate provided.

3. CLOSING TIME OF BIDS AND PROVISIONS RELATING TO SUBMISSION OF BIDS

- 3.1 The closing date and time for the receipt of bids in response to this invitation to bid is detailed on the cover page of this invitation to bid.
- 3.2 All bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope bearing the bid number, bid description and closing date.
- 3.3 All bids must be deposited before the closing time and date stipulated above in the bid box at the address detailed on the cover page of this invitation to bid.

4. **ENQUIRIES**

Should any bidder have any enquiries relating to this invitation to bid, such enquiries may only be addressed to the person/s detailed on the cover page to this invitation to bid at the number/s stipulated. Bidders are given until two (2) days before the closing date to forward enquiries regarding the tender.

5. COMPULSORY BID BRIEFING/SESSION

There is no compulsory briefing session for this tender

6. TAX CLEARANCE

The bidder should have compliant tax matters with SARS when submitting bid documentation. A pro forma application for Tax Clearance Certificate (SBD 2) is attached as Part 3 – Schedule B. Bidder must take specific note of the conditions stipulated in SBD 2. Tax clearance certificate and B-BBEE certificate must be renewed every 12 months and must be submitted to Supply Chain Management.

7. PRICING

- 7.1 The bidder(s) must submit details regarding the bid price for the Services on the Pricing Schedule form/s attached as Part 3 Schedule C which completed form/s must be submitted together with the bid documents.
- 7.2 Pricing stipulated must be **INCLUSIVE OF VALUE ADDED TAX.**
- 7.3 It is an express requirement of this invitation to bid that the bidders provide some transparency in respect to their pricing approach. In this regard, bidders must indicate the basis on which they have calculated their pricing by completing all aspects of the Pricing Schedule form Part 3 Schedule C.
- 7.4 The total price including VAT should be transferred to SBD1.

8. DECLARATION OF INTEREST

The bidder should submit a duly signed declaration of interest (SBD 4) together with the bid. The declaration of interest is attached as Part 3 – Schedule D.

9. PREFERENCE POINTS CLAIM FORMS

<u>Part 3- Schedule E</u> contains the Preference Points Claim Forms in terms of Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017 to be completed and signed by the bidder to the extent applicable and returned with this bid.

10. QUALIFICATIONS OF BIDDERS

Bidders must submit detailed information together with their bid and disclose the experience in the relevant trade together with present contracts. These details should be submitted together with the bid on the form attached as Part 3 – Schedule F.

11. ORGANISATION TYPE

In the case of the bidder being a partnership, close corporation or a company all certificates reflecting the names, identity numbers and address of the partners, members or directors (as the case may be) must be submitted with the bid. These details should be submitted on the form attached as <u>Part 3 – Schedule G</u>.

12. CONSORTIUM / JOINT VENTURE

- 12.1 It is recognized that bidders may wish to form consortia to provide the Services.
- 12.2 A bid in response to this invitation to bid by a consortium shall comply with the following Requirements:-
- 12.3 It shall be signed so as to be legally binding on all consortium members;
- 12.4 One of the members shall be nominated by the others as authorized to be the lead member and this authorization shall be included in the agreement entered into between the consortium members;
- 12.5 The lead member shall be the only authorized party to make legal statements, communicate with the SSA and receive instructions for and on behalf of any and all the members of the consortium;
- 12.6 A copy of the agreement entered into by the consortium members shall be submitted with the bid.
- 12.7 Each party to the Consortium must submit a BBBEE Status Level Verification certificate.
- 12.8 Each party to the Consortium must be tax compliant with SARS.
- 12.9 Preference points will only be awarded when a consolidated BBBEE Certificate is submitted.

12.10 Parties should be registered on the Central Supplier Database or be willing to register on such a database.

13. ORGANISATIONAL STRUCTURE

The bidder should submit a clear indication of the envisaged authorized organisational principles, procedures and functions for an effective delivery of the required Service. These details should be submitted on the form attached as Part 3 – Schedule H.

14. <u>DETAILS OF THE PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS NEAREST OFFICE TO</u> THE LOCATION OF THE CONTRACT

The bidder should provide full details regarding the bidders nearest office base in the province (see Part 3 of this invitation to bid). These details should be provided on the form attached as Part 3 – Schedule I. which completed form must be submitted together with the bid.

15. FINANCIAL PARTICULARS

Bidder must provide full details regarding its financial particulars and standing, which particulars should be submitted together with the bid on the form attached as $\underline{\text{Part 3}}$ – Schedule J

16. VALIDITY

Bid documentation submitted by the bidder will be valid and open for acceptance for a period of **(150) one hundred and fifty** calendar days from the closing date and time stipulated on the front cover of this invitation to bid.

17. ACCEPTANCE OF BIDS

- 17.1 The SSA does not bind itself to accept either the lowest or any other bid and reserves the right to accept the bid which it deems to be in the best interest of the Department.
- 17.2 The SSA reserves the right to award the bid in wholly or in part thereof.

18. NO RIGHTS OR CLAIMS

18.1 Receipt of the invitation to bid does not confer any right on any party in respect of the Services or in respect of or against the SSA. The SSA reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to

withdraw by notice to bidders any Services or combination of Services from the bid process, to terminate any party's participation in the bid process or to accept or reject any response to this invitation to bid on notice to the bidders without liability to any party. Accordingly, parties have no rights, expressed or implied, with respect to any of the Services as a result of their participation in the bid process.

18.2 The SSA, nor any of their respective directors, officers, employees, agents, representatives or advisors will assume any obligations for any costs or expenses incurred by any party in or associated with any appraisal and/or investigation relating to this invitation to bid or the subsequent submission of a bid in response to this invitation to bid in respect of the Services or any other costs, expenses or liabilities of whatsoever nature and howsoever incurred by bidders in connection with or arising out of the bid process.

19. NON DISCLOSURE, CONFIDENTIALITY AND SECURITY

- 19.1 The invitation to bid and its contents are made available on condition that they are used in connection with the bid process set out in the invitation to bid and for no other purpose. All information pertaining to this invitation to bid and its contents shall be regarded as restricted and divulged on a "need to know" basis with the approval of the SSA.
- 19.2 In the event that the bidder is appointed pursuant to this invitation to bid such bidder may be subject to security clearance prior to commencement of the Services.

20. ACCURACY OF INFORMATION

- 20.1 The information contained in the invitation to bid has been prepared in good faith. The SSA nor any of their respective directors, advisors, officers, employees, agents, representatives make any representation or warranty or give any undertaking express or implied, or accept any responsibility or liability whatsoever, as to the contents, accuracy or completeness of the information contained in the invitation to bid, or any other written or oral information made available in connection with the bid and nothing contained herein is, or shall be relied upon as a promise or representation, whether as to the past or the future.
- 20.2 This invitation to bid may not contain all the information that may be required to evaluate a possible submission of a response to this invitation to bid. The bidder should conduct its own independent analysis of the operations to the extent required to enable it to respond to this bid.

21. COMPETITION

- 21.1 Bidders and their respective officers, employees and agents are prohibited from engaging in any collusive action with respect to the bidding process which serves to limit competition amongst bidders.
- 21.2 In general, the attention of bidders is drawn to Section 4(1) (iii) of the Competition Act 1998 (Act No. 89 of 1998) (the Competition Act) that prohibits collusive bidding.

- 21.3 If bidders have reason to believe that competition issues may arise from any submission of a response to this bid invitation they are encouraged to discuss their position with the competition authorities before submitting response.
- 21.4 Any correspondence or process of any kind between bidders and the competition authorities must be documented in the responses to this invitation to bid.
- 21.5 Part 4 (Schedule F) should be completed and duly signed.

22. RESERVATION OF RIGHTS

- 22.1 Without limitation to any other rights of the SSA (whether otherwise reserved in this invitation to bid or under law), the SSA expressly reserves the right to:-
- 22.2 Request clarification on any aspect of a response to this invitation to bid received from the bidder, such requests and the responses to be in writing;
- 22.3 Amend the bidding process, including the timetables, closing date and any other date at its sole discretion.
- 22.4 Reject all responses submitted by bidders and to embark on a new bid process.

23. <u>SECURITY REQUIREMENTS</u>

- 23.1 <u>Part 3- Schedule K</u>: **Security clearances:** The bidder's (principal or joint venture contractor) employees and sub Bidders **are** required at all times during the contract period to be in possession of valid security clearances to the level determined by SSA commensurate with the nature of the project activities they are involved in. The cost of obtaining suitable clearances is for the account of the bidders.
- 23.2 The vendors shall supply and maintain a list of personnel involved on the account indicating their clearance status. Negative or failure of security clearance or vetting by the bidder bidder's employees or partners at any stage during the contracting or contract period and lack of or inability to obtain acceptable replacements by the contractor may lead to the cancellation of the contract. The Bidders and their sub-Bidders will be re-vetted for every event during the period of contracting (3 years).

24. PERIOD FOR THIS PROJECT

This is going to be an outright purchase of software inclusive maintenance and support for three year.

PART 2 Specifications

1. Introduction

SSA NC has a requirement and responsibility to review and enhance its cyber security capability, response and readiness through threat intelligence feed solution capabilities. For this reason, the following terms of reference will outline key deliverables (Project deliverables, Service Provider capabilities and Key deliverables for cyber solution /tools that a preferred service provider should meet, as well as key deliverables of the technical solution.

2. Scope

Terms of reference to identify and deliver a comprehensive cyber threat intelligence feed solution to assist in the capacitation of the SSA, National Communications in order to provide continuous and on demand ICT Security Monitoring and Information Assurance services.

2.1 Mandatory Requirements

Key Deliverables (Project):

- Service provider or cyber security vendor is required to deliver a successful implementation within a stipulated project plan due to the need for immediate interoperability between the key deliverables that will provide the maximum impact at the earliest opportunity and subsequent years.
- Service provider or cyber security vendor must demonstrate the ability to implement, maintain and support the solution and must provide a reference/s of where the solution is deployed.
- Where the service provider or cyber security vendor is not the OEM, a requirement to provide OEM
 details and assurance (verifiable proof) from the OEM as the capable and reputable reseller to
 provide maintenance, support and OEM training.

2.2 Required key deliverables are as follows (Service Provider):

- The service provider must provide valid OEM Authorization Certification that includes licensing, installation, configuration, building of rules and optimization with preferably the highest level of product support given by OEM to the service provider.
- The bidder must tender for a complete solution (where hardware or any other system or solution require additional components or add-ons).
- Threat intelligence feed solution: Provide solutions that are aligned with SSA NC business requirements in cyber threat intelligence feeds, and support response capabilities and processes.
- The cyber threat intelligence feed consultant should be able to work alongside the tactical NC personnel to deliver required enhanced, proactive threat intelligence feeds options.
- Training: Provide an appropriate package of dedicated training to SSA, NC team, that will increase
 fundamental cyber security expertise and awareness, while enhancing the skills of those at the
 practitioner level in malware analysis, cyber intelligence and incident response. The successful
 vendor should clearly demonstrate a plan to mature and transfer Mission-critical skills and
 capabilities to SSA, NC team.
- A proven market leader in local and global Cyber threat intelligence feeds tools and technologies implementation, support and maintenance. The service provider must possess technical expertise, skills and experience of minimum of 5 years on the solution.

3. **EVALUATION CRITERIA**

All bids will be evaluated in terms of compliance and preference point system which comprises of the following:

3.3 Phase 3: Price and B-BBEE stage evaluation in terms of the 80/20 preference point systems

3.3.1 The bid will be evaluated in terms of the 80/20 point system as stipulated in the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017. 80 points will be allocated for price and 20 points for attaining the B-BBEE status level of contributor.

The following formulae will be used in calculating points scored for price as follows:

$$Ps = 80 \left(1 - \frac{Pt - P \min}{P \min} \right)$$

Where

Ps = Points scored for comparative price of tender or offer under

Consideration

Pt = Comparative price of tender or offer under consideration; and

Pmin = Comparative price of lowest acceptable tender or off

Points scored must be rounded off to the nearest 2 decimal places.

NB: Bidders are required to, together with their bids submit original and valid B-BBEE status level verification certificates/affidavits or certified copies to substantiate their B-BBEE rating claim. A bidder will not be disqualified from the bidding process if the bidder does not submit a certificate substantiating the B-BBEE status level of contribution nor is a non-compliant contributor. Such a bidder will score 0 out of maximum of 20 points for B-BBEE. Total points scored will be calculated by adding points scored for price and B-BBEE Contributor Level.

3.3.2 Evaluation in terms of BBBEE points

Bidders are required to, together with their bids submit original and valid B-BBEE status level verification certificates or certified copies to substantiate their B-BBEE rating claims. A bid will not be disqualified from the bidding process if the bidder does not submit a certificate substantiating the B-BBEE status level of contribution nor is a non-compliant contributor. Such a bidder will score 0 out of maximum of 20 points for B-BBEE.

General Conditions of Contract and Special Conditions of Contracts

NOTES

The purpose of this document is to:

- (i) Draw special attention to certain general conditions applicable to government bids, contracts and orders; and
- (ii) To ensure that clients be familiar with regard to the rights and obligations of all parties involved in doing business with government.

In this document words in the singular also mean in the plural and vice versa and words in the masculine also mean in the feminine and neuter.

- The General Conditions of Contract will form part of all bid documents and may not be amended.
- Special Conditions of Contract (SCC) relevant to a specific bid, should be compiled separately for every bid (if applicable) and will supplement the General Conditions of Contract. Whenever there is a conflict, the provisions in the SCC shall prevail.

Part 3 - Schedule B

Application for Tax Clearance Certificate

TAX CLEARANCE REQUIREMENTS IT IS A CONDITION OF BIDDING:-

- It is an absolute requirement that the taxes of the successful bidder <u>must</u> be in order or that satisfactory arrangements have been made with the Receiver of Revenue to meet his / her obligations.
- 2.
