- 1.2. ALL BIDS MUST BE SUBMITTED ON THE OFFICIAL FORMS PROVIDED—(NOT TO BE RETYPED) OR IN THE MANNER PRESCRIBED IN THE BID DOCUMENT.
- 1.3. THIS BID IS SUBJECT TO THE PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT POLICY FRAMEWORK ACT, 2000 AND THE PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT REGULATIONS, 2017, THE GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT (GCC) AND, IF APPLICABLE, ANY OTHER SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT.

### PART 1

## **CONDITIONS OF BID**

## 1. BACKGROUND AND INTRODUCTORY PROVISIONS

1.1 Refer to Part 2 of this invitation to bid for background and introductory information relating to the Services and this invitation to bid.

## 2. OFFER AND SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- 2.1 Without detracting from the generality of clause below, bidders must submit a completed and signed and requisite bid forms attached as <u>Part 3</u>) with its bid. Bidders must take careful note of the conditions of award.
- 2.2 All bids submitted in reply to this invitation to bid should incorporate all the forms, parts, certificates and other documentation forming part of this invitation to bid, duly completed where required.
- 2.3 It is a requirement that Tax matters of a service provider must be complaint with SARS when submitting, during and at the award of this tender.
- 2.4 In the event that any form or certificate provided in Part 3 of this invitation to bid does not have adequate space for the bidder to provide the requested details, the bidder should attach an annexure to such form or certificate on which the requested details should be provided and the bidder should refer to such annexure in the form or certificate provided.

## 3. CLOSING TIME OF BIDS AND PROVISIONS RELATING TO SUBMISSION OF BIDS

- 3.1 The closing date and time for the receipt of bids in response to this invitation to bid is detailed on the cover page of this invitation to bid.
- 3.2 All bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope bearing the bid number, bid description and closing date.
- 3.3 All bids must be deposited before the closing time and date stipulated above in the bid box at the address detailed on the cover page of this invitation to bid.

## 4. ENQUIRIES

4.1 Should any bidder have any enquiries relating to this invitation to bid, such enquiries may only be addressed to the person/s detailed on the cover page to this invitation to bid at the number/s and email stipulated. Bidders are given until two (2) days before the closing date to forward enquiries regarding the tender.

## 5. COMPULSORY BID BRIEFING/SESSION

5.1 There will be **NO** briefing session for this tender.

## 6. TAX CLEARANCE

The bidder should have complaint tax matters with SARS when submitting bid documentation.

A pro forma application for Tax Clearance Certificate (SBD 2) is attached as Part 3 – Schedule

B. Bidder must take specific note of the conditions stipulated in SBD 2. Tax clearance certificate and B-BBEE certificate must be renewed every 12 months and must be submitted to Supply Chain Management.

## 7. DECLARATION OF INTEREST

7.1 The bidder should submit a duly signed declaration of interest (SBD 4) together with the bid. The declaration of interest is attached as <u>Part 3 – Schedule D.</u>

## 8. DECLARATION OF BIDDER'S PAST SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT PRACTICES

8.1 The bidder must complete the declaration and sign accordingly to submit with the bid. The declaration of bidder's past supply chain management practices is attached as <a href="Part 3">Part 3</a> <a href="Schedule E">Schedule E</a></a>

## 9. QUALIFICATIONS OF BIDDERS

9.1 Bidders must submit detailed information together with their bid and disclose the experience in the relevant trade together with present contracts. These details should be submitted together with the bid on the form attached as <a href="Part 3">Part 3</a> - Schedule G.

# 10. PARTNERSHIPS AND LEGAL ENTITIES

10.1 In the case of the bidder being a partnership, close corporation or a company all certificates reflecting the names, identity numbers and address of the partners, members or directors (as the case may be) must be submitted with the bid. These details should be submitted on the form attached as Part 3 – Schedule H.

## 11. CONSORTIUM / JOINT VENTURE

- 11.1 It is recognized that bidders may wish to form consortia to provide the Services.
- 11.2 A bid in response to this invitation to bid by a consortium shall comply with the following requirements:-

- 11.2.1 It shall be signed so as to be legally binding on all consortium members;
- 11.2.2 One of the members shall be nominated by the others as authorized to be the lead member and this authorization shall be included in the agreement entered into between the consortium members;
- 11.2.3 The lead member shall be the only authorized party to make legal statements, communicate with the SSA and receive instructions for and on behalf of any and all the members of the consortium;
- 11.2.4 A copy of the agreement entered into by the consortium members shall be submitted with the bid.
- 11.2.5 Each party to the Consortium must submit a BBBEE Status Level Verification certificate.
- 11.2.6 Each party to the Consortium must be tax compliant with SARS.
- 11.2.7 Preference points will only be awarded when a consolidated BBBEE Certificate is submitted.
- 11.2.8 Parties should be registered on the Central Supplier Database

## 12. ORGANISATIONAL PRINCIPLES

12.1 The bidder should submit a clear indication of the envisaged authorized organisational principles, procedures and functions for an effective delivery of the required Service. These details should be submitted on the form attached as Part 3 – Schedule I

# 13. DETAILS OF THE PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS NEAREST OFFICE TO THE LOCATION OF THE CONTRACT

## 14. FINANCIAL PARTICULARS

14.1 Bidder must provide full details regarding its financial particulars and standing, which particulars should be submitted together with the bid on the form attached as Part 3- Schedule K.

### 15. PREFERENCE POINTS CLAIM FORMS

15.1 <u>Part 3 – Schedule L</u> contains the Preference Points Claim Forms in terms of Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017 to be completed and signed by the bidder to the extent applicable and returned with this bid.

## 16. VALIDITY

16.1 Bid documentation submitted by the bidder will be valid and open for acceptance for a period of (150) one hundred and fifty calendar days from the closing date and time stipulated on the front cover of this invitation to bid.

### 17. ACCEPTANCE OF BIDS

- 17.1 The SSA does not bind itself to accept either the lowest or any other bid and reserves the right to accept the bid which it deems to be in the best interest of the Department.
- 17.2 The SSA reserves the right to award the bid in wholly or in part thereof.

#### 18. NO RIGHTS OR CLAIMS

- 18.1 Receipt of the invitation to bid does not confer any right on any party in respect of the Services or in respect of or against the SSA. The SSA reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to withdraw by notice to bidders any Services or combination of Services from the bid process, to terminate any party's participation in the bid process or to accept or reject any response to this invitation to bid on notice to the bidders without liability to any party. Accordingly, parties have no rights, expressed or implied, with respect to any of the Services as a result of their participation in the bid process.
- The SSA, nor any of their respective directors, officers, employees, agents, representatives or advisors will assume any obligations for any costs or expenses incurred by any party in or associated with any appraisal and/or investigation relating to this invitation to bid or the subsequent submission of a bid in response to this invitation to bid in respect of the Services or any other costs, expenses or liabilities of whatsoever nature and howsoever incurred by bidders in connection with or arising out of the bid process.

### 19. NON DISCLOSURE, CONFIDENTIALITY AND SECURITY

- 19.1 The invitation to bid and its contents are made available on condition that they are used in connection with the bid process set out in the invitation to bid and for no other purpose. All information pertaining to this invitation to bid and its contents shall be regarded as restricted and divulged on a "need to know" basis with the approval of the SSA.
- 19.2 In the event that the bidder is appointed pursuant to this invitation to bid such bidder may be subject to security clearance prior to commencement of the Services.

### 20. ACCURACY OF INFORMATION

20.1 The information contained in the invitation to bid has been prepared in good faith. The SSA nor any of their respective directors, advisors, officers, employees, agents, representatives make any representation or warranty or give any undertaking express or implied, or accept any responsibility or liability whatsoever, as to the contents, accuracy or completeness of the information contained in the invitation to bid, or any other written or oral information made

available in connection with the bid and nothing contained herein is, or shall be relied upon as a promise or representation, whether as to the past or the future.

20.2 This invitation to bid may not contain all the information that may be required to evaluate a possible submission of a response to this invitation to bid. The bidder should conduct its own independent analysis of the operations to the extent required to enable it to respond to this bid.

### 21. COMPETITION

- 21.1 Bidders and their respective officers, employees and agents are prohibited from engaging in any collusive action with respect to the bidding process which serves to limit competition amongst bidders.
- In general, the attention of bidders is drawn to Section 4(1)(iii) of the Competition Act 1998 (Act No. 89 of 1998) (the Competition Act) that prohibits collusive bidding.
- 21.3 If bidders have reason to believe that competition issues may arise from any submission of a response to this bid invitation they are encouraged to discuss their position with the competition authorities before submitting response.
- 21.4 Any correspondence or process of any kind between bidders and the competition authorities must be documented in the responses to this invitation to bid.
- 21.5 Part 4 (Schedule F) should be completed and duly signed.

# 22. RESERVATION OF RIGHTS

### 24. SECURITY REQUIREMENTS

- 24.1 **Security clearances:** The bidder's (principal or joint venture contractor) employees and sub-Bidders *are* required at all times during the contract period to be in possession of valid security clearances to the level determined by SSA commensurate with the nature of the project activities they are involved in. The cost of obtaining suitable clearances is for the account of the bidders.
- The vendors shall supply and maintain a list of personnel involved on the account indicating their clearance status. Negative or failure of security clearance or vetting by the bidder bidder's employees or partners at any stage during the contracting or contract period and lack of or inability to obtain acceptable replacements by the contractor may lead to the cancellation of the contract. The Bidders and their sub-Bidders will be re-vetted for every event during the period of contracting (3 years).

# 25. **EVALUATION CRITERIA**

- 25.1 Bids will be evaluated looking at capacity of the supplier to deliver supplies at the right quality and right location.
- 25.2 Only bids that demonstrated clearly to the SSA that the minimum requirements and specifications are met (see part 1 Conditions of Award) will be considered for further evaluation.

# 26. **PERIOD FOR THIS PROJECT**

A service level agreement (SLA) should be signed between the SSA and the service providers for a period of three (3) years.



## PART 2

### **SPECIFICATION**

### 1. INTRODUCTION

1.1. The State Security Agency (herein referred to as SSA or the Department) seeks proposals from experienced **Pharmaceutical Wholesalers and/or Distributors** to be listed on a panel of service providers to provide medication to the SSA Pharmacy situated at Rietvlei Pretoria for a period of three (3) years.

#### 2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1. The scope of pharmacy practice includes more traditional roles such as compounding and dispensing medications, and it also includes more modern services related to health care, including clinical services, reviewing medications for safety and efficacy, and providing drug information. Pharmacists, therefore, are the experts on drug therapy and are the primary health professionals who optimise use of medication for the benefit of the patients.
- 2.2. The Wholesaler distribution forms part of the supply chain of pharmaceutical products manufactured. The wholesaler will be responsible for the effective and efficient safe handling, storage and distribution of such products ensuring the quality of the process

### 3. SCOPE OF WORK AND DELIVERABLES

- 3.1 The Service Providers that are appointed to the panel will assist SSA as and when required to provide medicines prescribed by the doctors for the members of the SSA.
- 3.2 Service providers who meet the evaluation criteria provided below will be placed on a panel where-in all medication will be sourced using the **Single Exit Price (SEP).**
- 3.3 All the medicine that is registered on the MIMS document, and as updated every month will have to be made available for the members of the SSA, which will include bulk buying.
- 3.4 Delivery time must be within three (3) hours of placement of order.
- 3.5 One or two deliveries daily/every day.

- 3.6 Company must have the full range of ethical drugs.
- 3.7 Companies must be located within the province of Gauteng.
- 3.8 Service providers will be rotated and business be distributed equally, but preference will be given to the wholesaler who has stock on hand when satisfying patient prescriptions.
- 3.9 Deliveries must conform to cold chain distribution requirements, if applicable. Normal storage conditions (21 degree Celsius) must not be exceeded.
- 3.10 Labels and package inserts for medicines must comply with the medicines and related substances Act.
- 3.11 All solutions and injectable preparations are to be supplied sterile.
- 3.12 Containers for medical preparations must contain the quality and mechanical hazards of handling, transportation, prevent leakage and provide appropriate level of protection from environmental conditions.
- 3.13 Medication must be acceptable to the SSA at the point of delivery

#### 4. BID REQUIREMENTS

Service Provider Skill, Experience, Management by SSA, Time Frames and Formal Contract.

## 4.1 Time Frame and Formal Contract

(i) Successful bidder(s) will be required to enter into a formal contract with SSA. The applicant is expected to be available to commence with the contract on signing of the contract (commencement date).

# 4.2 Special Conditions, Bid Submission Requirements and Bid

The supplier/s should be compliant with the legal requirements of South African Medicines Control Council (MCC) as per the terms of medicines and related substance Act 101 of 1965 [22c (1) (b).

Medicines offered by the bidders must be registered on [S15] of the medicines and related substances Act.

Bidders must submit a certified copy of a valid certificate of registration as a responsible pharmacist with South African Pharmacy Council.

Government Procurement General Conditions of contract (GCC) as issued by National Treasury will be applicable on all instances. The general conditions are available on the National Treasury website (<a href="www.treasury.gov.za">www.treasury.gov.za</a>).

# 4.3 Technical Proposal

This part must contain at least the following:

(i) Covering letter signed by the Service Provider, *inter alia*:

Accepting the Rules of Bidding, Evaluation of Bids, and Bid Evaluation Criteria set out in the Terms of Reference;

The Bidder needs to indicate to us that he is responding as a Prime contractor, joint venture, consortium or partnership and list the parties concerned.

Attach an original Tax Clearance Certificate issued by South African Revenue Services (SARS)

Providing full contact details for the Service Provider and whether it is a member of an association of pharmaceutical companies (if applicable), if so, name of association and area where headquarters is situated.

The name, facsimile and telephone number of the Accounts Executive or Project Coordinator who will be in direct contact with SSA regarding the accounts (& modus operandi/procedures), an indication of his experience in SAP processes and the extent of his language competencies.

The following statement must be included in the letter:

[We hereby certify that all statements made with regard to this proposal are made by [enter name of applicant here] are accurate and factual, and that we are aware that SSA reserves the right to verify any information provided in this regard and that untrue statements may result in the proposal being declared non-compliant].

### 4.4 Bid Evaluation Methodology

- <u>Phase 1</u>: The evaluation will look at the compliance to (4.2) Rules of Bidding, Bid Submission Requirements for bidder who do not comply with any of the listed items will be disqualified.
- <u>Phase 2</u>: The evaluation will be based on the scoring the submitted proposals where-in the successful applicants must obtain at least 80 points to be listed on the preferred panel of service providers. The contract will be awarded according to the BEE level of the service provider. The first three service providers that have high level of BBBEE will be in the panel.

A Bid Evaluation Committee will be established by the SSA comprising of internal representatives. The committee will evaluate all bids received on or before the closing time and date, according to the criteria indicated herein. The evaluation Committee will

make a recommendation to the Bid Adjudication Committee and Director General for appointment of the preferred bidder.

The Bid Evaluation Committee reserves the right to call bidders to complete any outstanding elements of their bids, make presentations of their bids, and/or present Best and Final Offers, if required.

This tender will be evaluated in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000 (Act 5 of 2000), Paragraph 4 (1-5). The following are the number of points that will be awarded for the evaluation of the proposals, and the minimum qualifying score for listing onto the panel of service providers:

Category	Maximum points	Minimum Qualifying Score
Terms of Reference (Incl. Technical/Functional Proposal)	100	80

The Technical Proposals received will be evaluated in compliance to the complete Terms of Reference for which the minimum qualifying score will be **80 points** and only those bids that subsequently achieve **80 points** or more will qualify to be part of the panel of the preferred service providers.

The decision of SSA will be final. If the full complement of three suppliers are not suitable, SSA reserves the right to lower the qualifying companies to a number not less than two.

The tender value will be divided equally amongst the winning panel of companies on a rotational basis, in a financial year cycle.

Any bidder, which fails to submit any element of the Bid Submission Requirements set herein, may, at the discretion of the Evaluation Committee, be rejected as unsuitable for evaluation and will therefore not be further considered.

# 5. Evaluation Criteria

The following score sheet or criteria shall apply for scoring by the evaluation committee members in scoring compliant/qualifying bids meeting the minimum requirements.
