1. SPECIFICATIONS

1.1. INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

1.1.1. The Safety and Security Sector Education and Training Authority (SASSETA) is one of the twenty-one (21) Sector Education and Training Authorities (SETAs) established in terms of the Skills Development Act (Act 97 of 1998) as amended. SASSETA's licence has been renewed until 31st March 2030. SASSETA is classified as a schedule 3A Public Entity in terms of the Public Finance Management Act, (Act 1 of 1999, as amended). SASSETA reports to the Department of Higher Education and Training.

1.2. PURPOSE

- 1.2.1. SASETA seeks the services of a qualified and experienced service provider to undertake the following services at SASSETA officers (of approximately 4,000m² of floor space across the building):
 - 1.2.1.1. quarterly deep cleaning of carpets
 - 1.2.1.2. quarterly deep cleaning of 250 office chairs
 - 1.2.1.3. quarterly pest control

1.3. SCOPE OF WORK AND REQUIRED DELIVERABLES

- 1.3.1. The service provider will be required to attend to the following areas, but not limited to:
 - 1.3.1.1. Offices on the ground floor and 1st floor
 - 1.3.1.2. Corridors on the ground and 1st floor
 - 1.3.1.3. Front foyer
 - 1.3.1.4. Reception area
 - 1.3.1.5. Basement storage
 - 1.3.1.6. Boardrooms and storerooms
 - 1.3.1.7. Kitchens on the ground and 1st floor, etc
- 1.3.2. Deep Cleaning of Carpet
 - 1.3.2.1. Deep cleaning of all carpeted areas using professional equipment and cleaning materials.
 - 1.3.2.2. Use of eco-friendly and non-toxic cleaning materials.
- 1.3.3. Deep Cleaning of Chairs
 - 1.3.3.1. Deep cleaning of 250 chairs.
 - 1.3.3.2. Removal of visible stains and application of fabric-safe disinfectants.
- 1.3.4. pest control
 - 1.3.4.1. Pest control services of high touch areas at SASSETA (4000 sqm2) as and when required

1.4. COMPULSORY DOCUMENTS FOR SUBMISSION

1.4.1. The service provider must provide detailed Health and Safety sheets or specifications for all the chemicals to be used to ensure effective eradication of any virus and related components during:

- 1.4.1.1. quarterly deep cleaning of carpets
- 1.4.1.2. quarterly deep cleaning of 250 office chairs
- 1.4.1.3. quarterly pest control

The chemicals must be approved by the **South African bureau of standard (SABS)** or South **African National Accreditation system (SANAS)** or relevant health or Agricultural authority. **The relevant valid certificate/document** to be submitted with the quote.

- 1.4.2. The service provider must submit a valid cleaning certificate from a registered professional body (e.g. National contract cleaners association (NCCA) or cleaning association of South Africa (CASA), etc. The relevant valid certificate/document to be submitted with the quote.
- 1.4.3. The service provider must submit a valid pest control certificate from a registered professional body (e.g. South African pest control association) (SAPCA). The relevant valid certificate/document to be submitted with the quote.

NB: Non submission of all the certificates/letters/sheets will lead to automatic disqualification.

1.5. Requirements:

- 1.5.1. Prospective service providers should:
 - 1.5.1.1. Have access to modern cleaning equipment and techniques.

1.6. TIME FRAMES FOR DELIVERY OF THE WORK

1.6.1. The contract period is 36 months from the date of appointment

1.7. PRICING

- 1.7.1. Service Providers are requested to provide an all-inclusive cost of this project assignment on SBD 3.1.
- 1.7.2. Where the contract requires the successful bidder to travel to a venue different from SASSETA, the following travel and disbursement processes will be undertaken:
 - Claim travel mileage costs applicable to this contract as per the Department of Transport rates
 - Book only economy class flights
 - Book Group A hire cars, otherwise, Group B are to be used for Service Providers outside of Gauteng.
 - Utilise cost-effective mode of transport such as Uber/Taxify/Gautrain or shuttle services when travelling to and from the airport
 - Book only Bed and Breakfast, Hotels, or other equivalent accommodations up to a Rand value of R1 400/ three (3) Star per night per person (including dinner, breakfast and parking).
 - Submit all applicable invoices/receipts for the travel undertaken and also a Google map of the trip where travel by private car was undertaken for payment.
 - All travel to be approved by SASSETA before being undertaken.

1.8. ACCOUNTABILITY AND REPORTING

1.8.1. The service provider will report directly to the Auxiliary Practitioner as and when they deliver.

1.9. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

1.9.1. The service provider will be contracting with SASSETA. All products and data of this project, in whatever format raw or analyzed, will be the confidential information for utilization by SASSETA. All information and documents, received from SASSETA or stakeholders, is to be kept confidential and may not be used or distributed in any format without the written approval of SASSET. To this end, the service provider will be required to sign a confidentiality agreement within the Contract.

1.10. CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT (GCC) (ANNEXURE A)

1.10.1. Bidders are requested to initial each page of the General Conditions of Contract (GCC) (Annexure A) and submit their response to this Request for Quotations. The GCC will form part of the contract with the successful Bidder.

- 1.7 The organ of state reserves the right to request a bidder, either before a quotation is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by the organ of state.
