6. Casting and cross casting the annual financial statements;
7. Reviewing the accounting policies for appropriateness and consistency compared to prior signed AFS;
8. Reviewing appropriateness, accuracy and completeness of the disclosures;
9. High level review of overall compliance of the annual financial statements with GRAP;
10. Compile a report for Audit and Risk Committee;

1.6 The organ of state reserves the right to require of a tenderer, either before a tender is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by the organ of state.
