1 INVITATION

The PPECB invites interested Bidders to submit a completed Request for information (RFI) document for the retrofitting of the PPECB Laboratory in Centurion.

This RFI is an information gathering and market-testing exercise, intended only to inform and assist the PPECB's further planning and development of a specification for the competitive tender process.

2 SCOPE OF TERMS OF REFERENCE

The PPECB is to appoint a service provider that will be able to retrofit the PPECB Laboratory this includes demolishing and erecting dry walls; remove and replace carpets; remove and replace chemical resistant tiles; painting of all areas and installation or repairing of electrical points. The service providers to attend a compulsory site/briefing session at the laboratory. This is a qualifying RFI - Only the service providers who attend the compulsory site briefing session will be included in the Request for Proposal/ Competitive tender stage.

After the compulsory site briefing session, the service providers to submit their detailed proposal with all the scope of work to be completed, including labour and any other costs related to the project.

3 COMPANY BACKGROUND

The PPECB is a Schedule 3A entity in terms of the Public Finance Management Act 1 of 1999. The PPECB is established in terms of Section 2 of the Perishable Products Export Control Act 9 of 1983. The main purpose of the PPECB is to promote the orderly, efficient, and sustainable export of perishable products from South Africa. The PPECB manages and monitors the cold chain for the export of perishable products from South Africa. The PPECB operates under two mandates, namely the Agricultural Products Standards Act and the Perishable Products Standards Act 9 of 1983.

4 SCOPE OF WORK


