The following amendments to the tender requirements must be noted:

1. UIF COMPLIANCE CERTIFICATE

There is not longer a requirement to demonstrate UIF compliance in this tender.

2. PRICE ESCALATIONS

All prices will escalate in line with the illustrative pricing guide of the national bargaining council for the private security sector as per the effective date of the guide.

3. BODYCAM SPECIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

1. Video and Audio Quality

- **Video Resolution:** Minimum Full HD (1920x1080) at 30 frames per second (fps)
- **Field of View:** Wide-angle lens, minimum 120°
- **Audio:** Built-in microphone with noise cancellation for clear audio capture
- **Night Vision:** Infrared or low-light capability for clear recordings in dark environments

2. Storage and Battery

- **Storage Capacity:** Minimum 32GB internal memory; support for expandable storage or cloud upload
- **Battery Life:** Minimum 10 hours continuous recording on a single charge
- **Charging:** Compatible with docking stations for charging and data transfer

3. Durability and Design

- **Build:** Rugged, waterproof (IP67 or better), and shock-resistant
- **Size & Weight:** Compact and lightweight for comfortable all-day wear
- **Tamper Detection:** Alert and log any tampering or unauthorized device access

4. Connectivity and Features

- **Data Transfer:** USB 3.0 or wireless upload capability
- **Live Streaming:** Optional live video streaming via 4G/LTE or Wi-Fi
- **GPS:** Optional GPS tagging for location tracking
- **Encryption:** AES-256-bit encryption for stored and transmitted data
- **Authentication:** Support for RFID or biometric authentication (optional)

5. Software and Integration

- Compatible with existing Video Management System (VMS)
- Role-based access control for footage viewing and management
- Automatic data upload and retention policies
- Audit trail logging of user activity and device usage

6. Accessories

8. Retention Period

- **Standard Retention:** All recorded footage from body-worn cameras must be retained for a minimum of 30 days, in line with the retention period for other surveillance systems.
- **Extended Retention:** Footage related to incidents, investigations, or legal matters must be securely stored for the duration of the case or as per legal/organizational requirements.

9. Storage and Access Control

- Footage must be stored in a secure, encrypted environment, either on-premises or via a compliant cloud platform.
- Access must be role-based, with audit logs capturing all access, download, or deletion activities.

10. Automatic Deletion

- Non-flagged footage should be set for automatic deletion after the retention period, unless marked for extended retention.
- A system should be in place to flag and archive footage related to:
 - Security incidents
 - Disciplinary actions
 - Legal disputes
 - Customer complaints

11. Responsibility

- The Security or IT Department will be responsible for:
 - Managing storage
 - Ensuring policy compliance
 - Responding to data access or retrieval requests
