Service Providers will be selected as follows:

All Tenderers that meet the minimum threshold of 70% for functionality scoring will proceed to the next stage of the price and preference scoring.

- One (1) Invitation to tender (ITT) is issued with (1) set of NEC 3 Term Service Contracts detailing the scope of services.
- The 80/20 preference points system (Price evaluation and B-BBEE points scoring) will be applied per zone.
- This procurement process will result in the appointment of Service Providers, for both the KwaZulu-Natal and Free State OU's.
- The scope of work consists of the three following sections for **KZN OU**.
  - 1. MV/LV
  - 2. OHRSV

The outcome result will be the award of service provider(s) in the following three options:
