All Contractors that meet the minimum threshold of 92% will proceed to the next stage of price and preference scoring, drawing of lots if applicable and contractual requirements (SHEQ & Finance) One (1) Invitation to tender (ITT) is issued with (1) set of NEC 3 Term Service Contracts detailing the scope of services.

- One Price list (identical for both zones)
- The 80/20 preference points system (Price evaluation and B-BBEE points scoring) will be applied per zone.
