3 PROPOSAL SUBMISSION

Transnet has implemented a new electronic tender submission system, the e-Tender Submission Portal, in line with the overall Transnet digitalization strategy where suppliers can view advertised tenders, register their information, log their intent to respond to bids and upload their bid proposals/responses on to the system.

- a) The Transnet e-Tender Submission Portal can be accessed as follows:

 - Click on "TENDERS";
 - Scroll towards the bottom right hand side of the page;
 - On the blue window click on "register on our new eTender Portal";

 - Click on "SIGN IN/REGISTER for bidder to register their information (must fill in all mandatory information);
 - Click on "SIGN IN/REGISTER" to sign in if already registered;
 - Toggle (click to switch) the "Log an Intent" button to submit a bid;
 - Submit bid documents by uploading them into the system against each tender selected.

4 RFP INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Please sign documents [sign, stamp and date the bottom of each page] before uploading them on the system. The person or persons signing the submission must be legally authorised by the respondent to do so.

4.2 All returnable documents tabled in the Proposal Form [Section 5] must be returned with proposals.

- 4.3 Unless otherwise expressly stated, all Proposals furnished pursuant to this RFP shall be deemed to be offers. Any exceptions to this statement must be clearly and specifically indicated.
- 4.4 Any additional conditions must be embodied in an accompanying letter. Subject only to [Alterations made by the Respondent to Bid Prices] of the General Bid Conditions, (Legal Review) and Section 6 of the RFP, alterations, additions or deletions must not be made by the Respondent to the actual RFP documents.

5 JOINT VENTURES OR CONSORTIUMS

Respondents who would wish to respond to this RFP as a Joint Venture [JV] or consortium with B-BBEE entities, must state their intention to do so in their RFP submission. Such Respondents must also submit a signed JV or consortium agreement between the parties clearly stating the percentage [%] split of business and the associated responsibilities of each party. If at the time of the bid submission such a JV or consortium agreement has not been concluded, the partners must submit confirmation in writing of their intention to enter into a JV or consortium agreement should they be awarded business by Transnet through this RFP process. This written confirmation must clearly indicate the percentage [%] split of business and the responsibilities of each party.



In such cases, award of business will only take place once a signed copy of a JV or consortium agreement is submitted to Transnet.

Respondents are to note that for the purpose of Evaluation:

- a JV will be evaluated based on one consolidated B-BBEE score card as per the B-BBEE Preferential
 Procurement Regulations, 2017 preference point scoring.
- Experience, qualification or certification of Lead Bidder (JV Partner with higher % split of Business)
 must have the required Experience, qualification or certification, where the split of business is 50/50,
 Experience, qualification or certification of either member of the JV will be used for evaluation.

6 COMMUNICATION

- 6.1 Specific queries relating to this RFP before the closing date of the RFP should be submitted to the contact person specified in Section 1 of this RFP before 12:00 pm on 02 August July 2022. In the interest of fairness and transparency Transnet's response to such a query will then be made available to other bidders.
- 6.2 It is prohibited for Respondents to attempt, either directly or indirectly, to canvass any officer or employee of Transnet in respect of this RFP between the closing date and the date of the award of the business.
- 6.3 Respondents found to be in collusion with one another will be automatically disqualified and restricted from doing business with organs of state for a specified period.
- 6.4 Respondents may also, at any time after the closing date of the RFP, communicate with the contact person specified in Section 1 of this RFP on any matter relating to its RFP response
- 6.5 Respondents are to note that changes to its submission will not be considered after the closing date.

7 CONFIDENTIALITY

All information related to this RFP is to be treated with strict confidence. In this regard Respondents are required to certify that they have acquainted themselves with the Non-Disclosure Agreement. All information related to a subsequent contract, both during and after completion thereof, will be treated with strict confidence. Should the need however arise to divulge any information related to this RFP or the subsequent contract, written approval must be obtained from Transnet.

8 COMPLIANCE

The successful Respondent [hereinafter referred to as the **Service Provider** shall be in full and complete compliance with any and all applicable laws and regulations.

9 EMPLOYMENT EQUITY ACT

Respondents must comply with the requirements of the Employment Equity Act 55 of 1998 applicable to it including (but not limited to) Section 53 of the Employment Equity Act.

10 DISCLAIMERS

Respondents are hereby advised that Transnet is not committed to any course of action as a result of its issuance of this RFP and/or its receipt of Proposals. In particular, please note that Transnet reserves the right to:

- 10.1 modify the RFP's Goods/Services and request Respondents to re-bid on any such changes;
- 10.2 reject any Proposal which does not conform to instructions and specifications which are detailed herein;



- 10.3 disqualify Proposals submitted after the stated submission deadline [closing date];
- 10.4 award a contract in connection with this Proposal at any time after the RFP's closing date;
- 10.5 award a contract for only a portion of the proposed Goods/Services which are reflected in the scope of this RFP;
- 10.6 split the award of the contract between more than one Supplier/Service provider, should it at Transnet's discretion be more advantageous in terms of, amongst others, cost or developmental considerations;
- 10.7 cancel the bid process;
- 10.8 validate any information submitted by Respondents in response to this bid. This would include, but is not limited to, requesting the Respondents to provide supporting evidence. By submitting a bid, Respondents hereby irrevocably grant the necessary consent to Transnet to do so;
- 10.9 request audited financial statements or other documentation for the purposes of a due diligence exercise;
- 10.10 not accept any changes or purported changes by the Respondent to the bid rates after the closing date and/or after the award of the business, unless the contract specifically provided for it;
- 10.11 to cancel the contract and/request that National Treasury place the Respondent on its Database of Restricted Suppliers for a period not exceeding 10 years, on the basis that a contract was awarded on the strength of incorrect information furnished by the Respondent or on any other basis recognised in law;
- 10.12 to award the business to the next ranked bidder, provided that he/she is still prepared to provide the required Goods/Services at the quoted price, should the preferred bidder fail to sign or commence with the contract within a reasonable period after being requested to do so. Under such circumstances, the validity of the bids of the next ranked bidder(s) will be deemed to remain valid, irrespective of whether the next ranked bidder(s) were issued with a Letter of Regret. Bidders may therefore be requested to advise whether they would still be prepared to provide the required Goods/Services at their quoted price, even after they have been issued with a Letter of Regret.

Note that Transnet will not reimburse any Respondent for any preparatory costs or other work performed in connection with its Proposal, whether or not the Respondent is awarded a contract.

11 LEGAL REVIEW

A Proposal submitted by a Respondent will be subjected to review and acceptance or rejection of its proposed contractual terms and conditions by Transnet's Legal Counsel, prior to consideration for an award of business. A material deviation from the Standard terms or conditions could result in disqualification.

12 SECURITY CLEARANCE

Acceptance of this bid could be subject to the condition that the Successful Respondent, its personnel providing the Goods/Services and its subcontractor(s) must obtain security clearance from the appropriate authorities to the level of **CONFIDENTIAL/ SECRET/TOP SECRET**. Obtaining the required clearance is the responsibility of the Successful Respondent. Acceptance of the bid is also subject to the condition that the Successful Respondent will implement all such security measures as the safe performance of the contract may require.

13 NATIONAL TREASURY'S CENTRAL SUPPLIER DATABASE

Respondents are required to self-register on National Treasury's Central Supplier Database (CSD) which has been established to centrally administer supplier information for all organs of state and facilitate the verification of certain key supplier information. Respondents must register on the CSD prior to submitting their bids.



Business may not be awarded to a Respondent who has failed to register on the CSD. Only foreign suppliers with no local registered entity need not register on the CSD.

For this purpose, the attached SBD 1 form must be completed and submitted as a mandatory returnable document by the closing date and time of the bid.

14 TAX COMPLIANCE

Respondents must be compliant when submitting a proposal to Transnet and remain compliant for the entire contract term with all applicable tax legislation, including but not limited to the Income Tax Act, 1962 (Act No. 58 of 1962) and Value Added Tax Act, 1991 (Act No. 89 of 1991).

It is a condition of this bid that the tax matters of the successful Respondents be in order, or that satisfactory arrangements have been made with South African Revenue Service (SARS) to meet the Respondents tax obligations.

The Tax Compliance status requirements are also applicable to foreign Respondents/ individuals who wish to submit bids.

Where Consortia / Joint Ventures / Sub-contractors are involved, each party must be registered on the Central Supplier Database and their tax compliance status will be verified through the Central Supplier Database.





SECTION 3: BACKGROUND, OVERVIEW AND SCOPE OF REQUIREMENTS

1 BACKGROUND

The Transnet-Phelophepa Health Care Train Project operates in all nine provinces of South Africa, providing comprehensive primary health care services to patients while the trains are stationed at railway stations. These health services include a range of specific laboratory / pathology tests to make a full diagnosis for the patient. The Health Clinic also does screening and testing for chronic illnesses such as cancer, diabetes and hypertension. In the case of needle stick injuries, the Health and Dental Clinics do HIV/AIDS tests on students and patients and the results are sent to the laboratory.

2 DETAILED SCOPE OF WORK

Transnet seek to appoint a competent Service Provider to provide comprehensive range of laboratory services that include a patient / staff and student laboratory / pathology tests wherever the two trains may be stationed. The Services shall be on an as-and-when required basis, according to the diagnostic needs of the patient. Phelophepa Stations are listed in Table 3, however the stations are subject to change, as such a national footprint is required.

The Service Provider is required to perform the following services:

2.1 Laboratory Testing

The Service Provider is required to provide laboratory services including collection of specimens from the Phelophepa Health care train for processing. The collection and transportation of samples to the laboratory for processing must be handled with care and according to South African Industry regulatory standards, requirements and guidelines applicable to these tests. Sampling is normally conducted by clinicians on Phelophepa and stored according to the relevant protocols.

The specimens to be processed are both routine and emergency specimens. Routine specimens include but not limited to: Prostate Antigen Analysis (PSA bloods) and Pap smears. Emergency specimens include urgent processing of blood specimens in cases of staff accidental exposure to contaminated body fluids such as eye splashes and needle prick injuries. These include but are not limited to for example, : HIV ELISA testing, FBC, Hep B, Hep A etc. During the contractual period, the test request order will be given together with the samples to the Service Provider.

Staff medical surveillance may include FBCs, U&E, Hep b, Hep A, Sputum etc.

2.2 Provision of Consumables and Support

The Service Provider is required to supply the specimen collection tools required for storage and transportation of patients' samples such as: blood tubes, specimen holders, labels, pap smear kits, clear plastic holders for the forms & specimens; including but not confined to, liquid and conventional cytology. This is as per the Department of Health requirements and standards governing the industry.

The Service Provider is further required to supply Laboratory forms (e.g. Haematology and cytology forms) and labels according to the Lab's requirements as per protocols.



2.3 Timeous Supply of Duplicate Patient Results

Due to the nature of the project, Phelophepa is often in an area for a minimum of one (1) week and a maximum of two (2) weeks.

The Service Provider is required to generate two (2) copies of results for the routine specimens (PSA & Pap Smears). One copy to the patient's nearest local clinic and the second copy to Phelophepa. The patient's closest clinic will be indicated on the request form, as well as the address for Head Office or Health Clinic/ Dental Manager to receive results on the trains and in emergencies. The request for copies to be sent to patients' clinic is to ensure that there is continuity of care and the local Department of Health team can follow up on abnormalities and emergency cases.

Emergency results should be submitted to the relevant requesting clinician on Phelophepa via email as provided on the request form.

2.4 Turnaround Time

The Service Provider is required to provide results within a turnaround time (TAT) as follows:

A 12-hour maximum turn-around time is requested for emergency specimens and a maximum of 72 hours for all other specimens to ensure continuity of care.

Test results should be available within specified TAT via:

- Hard copies
- SMS (for selected results, as per protocol)
- Web-based system for authorized users or through a mobile APP function to track results
- A system should be in place to accommodate and attend telephonic enquiries from clinicians should a need arise
- Provisional results should be made available as appropriate
- Reports should include full interpretation and reference ranges as appropriate.
- Amended results should be indicated on the report and the clinician informed.
- Delayed reporting: any delays in TAT of results due to temporary laboratory service interruption should be communicated to the client / referring clinician.

2.5 List of Test Requirements

The following types of tests should be conducted according to standard specifications, equipment and techniques stipulated by regulations.
