1. INTRODUCTION

The scope entails the supply and delivery of Instrumentation and Automation equipment spares for all Rand Water Sites. The spares shall be supplied over a period of 36 months. - a) The list of equipment is as per the attached Automation Spares BOQs.
- b) The spares are to replace defective components in the plant therefore the exact match must be supplied to prevent major system reconfiguration. If the exact match cannot be acquired either through obsolescence or any other valid reason, the supplier shall contact the client and propose an alternative for approval.
- c) The equipment must be supplied in their original sealed packaging from the manufacturer.
- d) The equipment must be transported according to the recommendations of the manufacturer.
- e) The equipment must be accompanied by any verification/calibration certificates from the manufacturer to give confidence of their compliance to quality objectives.
- f) Each piece of equipment must be supplied with any relevant documentation or configuration software if this is a standard issue from the supplier.

- i) Bidders may choose items as per one of the groups from 1 to 5 of items they want to bid for.
