- If this is a maintenance item, could Eskom please provide an asset register or schedule indicating the number of systems, their locations, and the components included in the maintenance scope?
- If new installations are required, could Eskom please provide the technical specifications and installation requirements to enable accurate pricing?

We kindly request clarification on the following:

- Does the quantity of **60** represent the **60-month contract duration**, or does it refer to the number of electric fencing and CCTV systems/sites to be maintained?

 - The number of CCTV cameras and associated equipment;
 - The extent of the electric fencing infrastructure (including fence lengths, zones, energisers, and associated components);
 - The locations/sites where the maintenance services will be required or do all sites as stipulated in the tender have existing CCTV that need maintenance
- Are there any new CCTV or electric fencing installations anticipated during the contract period that should be included in the tender pricing? If so, kindly provide the quantities.

3. Central Control Room (Quantity: 48)

Kindly clarify the scope of this item:

- Does the quantity of **48** represent **48 months of maintenance/service**, or does it refer to another unit of measurement?

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- Could Eskom please confirm the services expected under the Central Control Room scope, including whether it covers preventive maintenance only, corrective maintenance, monitoring equipment, software, servers, operator workstations, display systems, UPSs, networking equipment, and any associated control room infrastructure?
- If equipment replacement or upgrades are anticipated during the contract period, should these be included in the tender pricing, or will they be instructed separately?

Your clarification will assist us in ensuring that our pricing accurately reflects Eskom's intended scope of work and avoids any assumptions.

We would appreciate your clarification regarding the following items under **Work Package 2:**

1. Public Address System (Quantity: 51)

Kindly clarify the intended scope of this item:

- Does the quantity of **51** represent existing Public Address Systems that require maintenance, or does it refer to new systems to be supplied and installed? **This (51 months) refers to the total number that your company will be invoicing Eskom for cost of the Public Address Systems over the contractual period of 60 months. It is assumed that it will take you 9 months from contract inception to procure and install the PA system and once Eskom engineering has signed off then the supplier can start invoicing for the incurred costs.**
- If this is a maintenance item, could Eskom please provide an asset register or schedule indicating the number of systems, their locations, and the components included in the maintenance scope? **This is a new item that would need to be installed and maintained over the contractual period.**
- If new installations are required, could Eskom please provide the technical specifications and installation requirements to enable accurate pricing? **Please refer to the technical specification that were provided in Addendum 1 .**

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2. Maintenance of Electric Fencing and CCTV (Quantity: 60)

We kindly request clarification on the following:

- Does the quantity of **60** represent the **60-month contract duration**, or does it refer to the number of electric fencing and CCTV systems/sites to be maintained? **Yes it is the 60 month contract duration for the existing fence maintenance.**
- If this item relates to the maintenance of existing infrastructure, could Eskom please provide an asset register or schedule indicating: **This is confidential information that will only be shared with shortlisted tenderers**
 - The number of CCTV cameras and associated equipment;
 - The extent of the electric fencing infrastructure (including fence lengths, zones, energisers, and associated components);
 - The locations/sites where the maintenance services will be required or do all sites as stipulated in the tender have existing CCTV that need maintenance
- Are there any new CCTV or electric fencing installations anticipated during the contract period that should be included in the tender pricing? If so, kindly provide the quantities. **This is confidential information that will only be shared with shortlisted tenderers**

3. Central Control Room (Quantity: 48)

Kindly clarify the scope of this item:

- Does the quantity of **48** represent **48 months of maintenance/service**, or does it refer to another unit of measurement? **This represents the number of months for the supplier to recover the costs incurred in putting up the central control room. It is assumed that it will take you 12 months of installation and the rest of the 48 months of the 60 months contract duration will be allocated for cost recovery via monthly invoicing.**
- Could Eskom please confirm the services expected under the Central Control Room scope, including whether it covers preventive maintenance only, corrective maintenance, monitoring equipment, software, servers, operator workstations, display systems, UPSs, networking equipment, and any associated control room infrastructure? **This information is covered under scope in the tender document and also in the presentation posted through Addendum 2**

If equipment replacement or upgrades are anticipated during the contract period, should these be included in the tender pricing, or will they be instructed separately? **There is no central control room at the moment and the supplier is expected to install necessary equipment in the room that was shown during the clarification briefing and therefore pricing thereof should be included as part of work package 2.**
