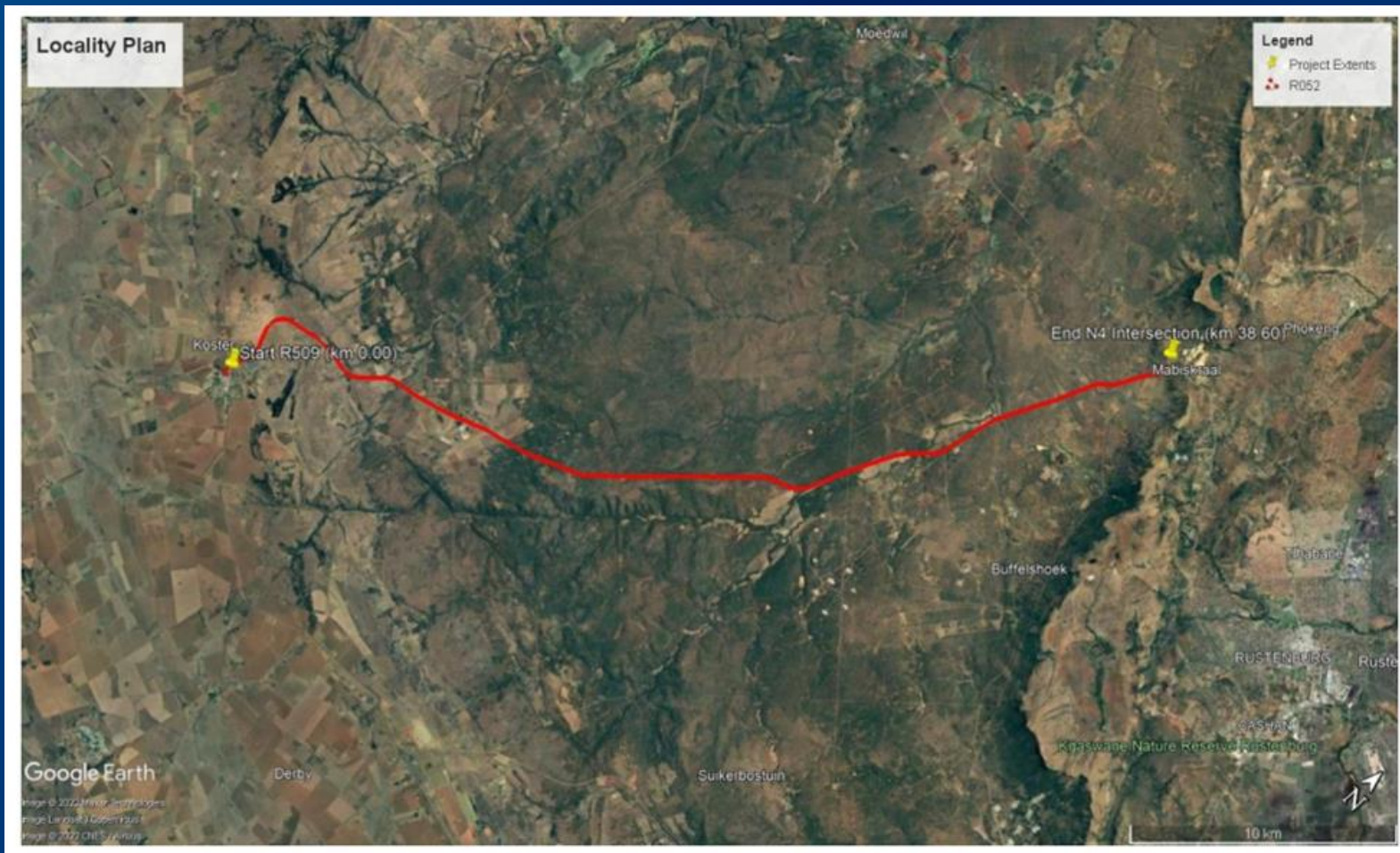

TENDER REQUIREMENTS - ELIGIBILITY

The eligibility criteria as set out in Clause C2.1 are as follows:

- a) Joint Venture with a consolidated project specific B-BBEE scorecard.
 - i. The Lead Partner shall be a SANAS accredited laboratory.
 - ii. The Targeted Partner(s) is(are) defined in accordance with the requirements of SANS 10845 Part 6 (table B.2) as.
 - A QSE, EME or Start-up and
 - 51% black owned and
 - Status Level 1 or 2 B-BBEE contributor and
 - Minimum of 30% equity JV (**CIDB JV agreement to be provided**)
- b) Meet the minimum requirements for the key persons as stated in the Scope of Works.
 - i. Senior Site Laboratory Manager (**Highest qualification** and **affidavit** from candidate regarding years' experience to be provided):
 - Relevant National Diploma and minimum 10 years relevant experience or
 - Relevant NQF 6 qualification and minimum 10 years relevant experience; or
 - Grade 12 and minimum 15 years relevant experience or
 - Relevant NQF 4 and minimum 15 years relevant experience

TENDER REQUIREMENTS – ELIGIBILITY CONT.

- ii. Assistant (Trainee) Laboratory Manager (Highest qualification certificate and affidavit from candidate regarding years' experience to be provided):
 - Grade 12 and 7 years relevant experience, or
 - NQF 4 and 7 years relevant experience, or
 - an additional 2 years relevant experience for each year of schooling below Grade 12
- iii. Quality Assurance Manager: (**Copies of qualification certificates** and **affidavit** from candidate regarding years' experience to be provided)
 - Minimum 8 years' relevant experience in Civil Engineering Materials Testing
 - Valid certificate for Laboratory Systems Course based on ISO 17025
 - Valid certificate for Internal Auditing Course based on ISO 17025
- c) National Treasury Central Supplier Database.
 - i. Each member of the JV, shall be registered on the National Treasury Central Supplier Database on the closing date for tender submissions. Tenders received from such tenderers who do not comply with this requirement will not be considered.
- d) The Service Provider and his Subcontractors shall be registered with the Bargaining Council for the Civil Engineering Industry (Government Notice R.490 – Part III contained in Government Gazette No. 37750) and rates for wages and conditions of labour agreed by the Bargaining Council for the Civil Engineering Industry shall apply to the Service Provider and all his Subcontractors except where a specific industry publishes its own wage rates and conditions of labour.

TENDER REQUIREMENTS – ELIGIBILITY CONT.

Failure to satisfy the eligibility criteria will result in a non-responsive tender.

It is the tenderers responsibility to ensure that they adhere to all the eligibility criteria.

It should also be noted that the SANS 10845 Part 6 (table B.2), clearly states that the Targeted Enterprise (JV) must be an independent entity. Therefore, no directors / trustees / shareholders / members / partner or any person having controlling interest in the main laboratory may have an interest in the Targeted Enterprise. The entities must be **independent**.

TENDER REQUIREMENTS – B-BBEE

The following are requirements for a **VALID** B-BBEE Certificate or Sworn Affidavit, refer to Clause 3.11 as well as the notes to tenderer on Form A13. A summary of the requirements are provided below:

1. A tenderer's scorecard shall be a B-BBEE Certificate issued in accordance with:
 - i. the amended Construction Sector Codes published in Notice 931 of 2017 of Government Gazette No. 41287 on 1 December 2017 by the Department of Trade and Industry; or
 - ii. in the event that the Measured Entity operates in more than one sector or a sub-sector, the scorecard for the sector or sub-sector in which the majority of its core activities (measured in terms of annual revenue) are located will be acceptable.
2. The scorecard shall be submitted as a certificate attached to Returnable Schedule Form A13;
 - i. The certificate shall:
 - ii. Have been issued by a Verification Agency accredited by the South African National Accreditation System (SANAS); or
 - iii. Be in the form of a sworn affidavit or a certificate issued by the Companies and Intellectual Property Commission in the case of an Exempted Micro Enterprise (EME) with a total annual revenue of less than R1.8 million, if issued in accordance with the amended Construction Sector Codes published in Notice 931 of Government Gazette No 41287 on 1 December 2017 by the Department of Trade and Industry; or
 - iv. be in the form of a sworn affidavit or a certificate issued by the Companies and Intellectual Property Commission in the case of an Exempted Micro Enterprise (EME) with a total annual revenue of less than R3 million if issued in accordance with the amended Construction Sector Codes published in Notice 931 of 2017 of Government Gazette No. 41287 on 1 December 2017 by the Department of Trade and Industry; and
 - v. have a date of issue less than 12 (twelve) months prior to the original advertised tender closing date (see Tender Data C.2.15); and
 - vi. Be valid at the tender closing date; and
 - vii. Have a date of issue less than 12 (twelve) months prior to the tender closing date (see Tender Data C.2.15); and

TENDER REQUIREMENTS – B-BBEE

3. A valid B-BBEE Certificate must contain:
 - i. Name of enterprise as per enterprise registration documents issued by CIPC, and enterprise business address.
 - ii. Value-Added Tax number, where applicable.
 - iii. The B-BBEE Scorecard against which the certificate is issued, indicating all elements and scores achieved for each element. The actual score achieved must be linked to the total points as per the relevant Codes.
 - iv. B-BBEE status with corresponding procurement recognition level.
 - v. Have a date of issue and expiry (e.g. 9 June 2018 to 8 June 2019). Where a measured entity was subjected to a re-verification process, due to material change, the B-BBEE Verification Certificate must reflect the initial date of issue, date of re-issue and the initial date of expiry. Re-verification does not extend the lifespan of the B-BBEE Verification Certificate;
 - vi. Financial period which was used to issue the B-BBEE Verification Certificate.
4. A valid Sworn Affidavit must contain:
 - i. Name/s of deponent as they appear in the identity document and the identity number.
 - ii. Designation of the deponent as either the director, owner or member must be indicated in order to know that person is duly authorised to depose of an affidavit.
 - iii. Name of enterprise as per enterprise registration documents issued by the CIPC, where applicable, and enterprise business address.
 - iv. Percentage black ownership, black female ownership and whether they fall within a designated group.
 - v. Indicate total revenue for the year under review and whether it is based on audited financial statements or management accounts.
 - vi. Financial year-end as per the enterprise's registration documents, which was used to determine the total revenue. The valid format of the Financial Year-End is Day/Month/Year.
 - vii. B-BBEE status level. An enterprise can only have one status level.
 - viii. Date deponent signed and date of Commissioner of Oath must be the same.
 - ix. Commissioner of Oath cannot be an employee or ex officio of the enterprise because, a person cannot by law, commission a sworn affidavit in which they have an interest.

TENDER REQUIREMENTS – B-BBEE

5. Compliance with any other information requested to be attached to Returnable Schedule Form; and
6. The requirement for a Joint Venture (JV) is that, a consolidated project specific B-BBEE Verification Certificate in the name of the JV shall be submitted.
7. The points scored by a tenderer for B-BBEE must be added to the points scored for price.
8. The points scored must be rounded off to the nearest two decimal places.
9. Failure to submit a valid Verification Certificate will result in the award of 0 (zero) points for preference;
10. The Employer will not be responsible to acquire data that it needs for its own reporting systems and which may not form part of a verification agency's standard certificate format. The tenderer, at its own cost, must acquire any missing specified data listed in 4 above from its selected verification agency and have it recorded on the certificate. Alternatively, such missing data must be supplied separately, but certified as correct by the same verification agency and also attached to this form.

TENDER REQUIREMENTS – B-BBEE

10. The attached verification certificate and the associated assessment report shall comply with the requirements of Tender Data clause C.3.11.8 and shall identify:
 - i. The name and domicilium citandi et executandi of the tenderer.
 - ii. The registration and VAT number of the tenderer.
 - iii. The dates of granting of the B-BBEE score and the period of validity.
 - iv. The expiry date of the verification certificate.
 - v. A unique identification number.
 - vi. The standard and/or normative document, including the issue and/or revision used to evaluate the tenderer.
 - vii. The name and/or mark/logo of the B-BBEE verification agency.
 - viii. The category (Generic, QSE, EME) in which the tenderer has been measured.
 - ix. The B-BBEE status level.
 - x. The South African National Accreditation System (SANAS) logo on the verification certificate once verification agencies have been accredited.
 - xi. The B-BBEE procurement recognition level.
 - xii. The score achieved per B-BBEE element.
 - xiii. The % black shareholding.
 - xiv. The % black women shareholding.
 - xv. The % black persons with disabilities shareholding
 - xvi. The % black youth shareholding
 - xvii. The % black people living in rural or underdeveloped areas or townships shareholding
 - xviii. The % black military veterans shareholding
 - xix. The value-added status of the tenderer.

Any B-BBEE certificate or affidavit not complying with any of the above-mentioned requirements will result in the tenderer being declared non-responsive.

DESCRIPTION OF THE WORK

The following laboratory classes are required for the project:

- Soils Laboratory: Class A
- Concrete Laboratory: Class B
- Asphalt Laboratory: Class C
- Seals Laboratory: Class A

The following is a summary of the work that will be carried out under the main works contract.

- Major Roadworks consisting of:
 - Vertical alignment changes
 - Widening of the cross section by adding 3m shoulders
 - Formalising of all major intersection with dedicated right turning lanes
 - Strengthening of the pavement by means of:
 - Recycling of base to create stabilized subbase
 - Importation of new G1 base
 - Multiple seal layer consisting of 20mm and two 7.1mm aggregate.
 - Asphalt surfacing with rolled in chips
 - Ancillary Works (Guardrails, Roadsign, Roadmarkings)
- Structural works including widening of major culverts, lesser culverts
- Electrical streetlighting within Koster and Reagile
