The Supplier shall supply all the labour, tools, material, equipment, consumables, facilities, testing, and supervision required for servicing the specified equipment on site.

2. INFORMATION REQUIRED

- 2.1. Tenders shall provide enough details at the tendering stage to enable the Transnet Technical Officers the opportunity to assess each offer properly.
- 2.2. Tenders shall complete the relevant questionnaire in full and must indicate whether their offer complies with each item of the specification.
- 2.3. Should there be insufficient space for providing full details, bidders shall provide the additional details in their covering letter. The additional details shall be numbered in accordance with the applicable clause specified in the specification.
- 2.4. Material Certificates for all purchased item listed on the specification should be provided on the same date of delivery.

3. GENERAL REQUIREMENT

- 3.1. Suppliers shall comply with the Occupational Health and Safety Act (Act 85 of 1993), as amended. This applies to any work done as well as any equipment supplied.
- 3.2. The dedicated supplier personnel shall complete a SAFETY INDUCTION and have valid permits when entering Transnet Engineering's facilities.
- 3.3. Supplier personnel shall always wear the appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) on site.
- 3.4. Supplier shall have a valid Letter of Good standing with the Workman's Compensation Fund.
- 3.5. Supplier shall comply with the last version of Transnet Engineering's Safety, Health and Environment (SHE) Specification for contract work.
