STATEMENT OF WORK (SOW)

1. Introduction

The Construction Section under Operations Division at Armscor Dockyard in Simon's Town has a requirement for the procurement of a CNC Press Brake Bending Machine. The bidder shall deliver, install and commission the CNC Press Brake Bending Machine at Armscor Dockyard in Simon's Town.

1.1 Background

Armscor Dockyard is currently in the process of capacitating, as the third level maintenance and refit agency of the South African Navy (SAN). The organisation must be equipped to fulfil the mandate of executing maintenance on various systems utilised by the SAN up to at least Depth C. Depth C maintenance requires spares to be carried out, therefore manufacturing is involved in manufacturing those spares. The Shipwrights workshop under Construction Section requires a Press Brake Bending Machine to bend various types of metal sheets for welding to form the desired spares required to refurbish vessels.

2. Statement of Requirements

2.1 Deliverables:

One (1) brand-new CNC Press Brake Bending Machine.

2.2 Specifications:

The offered equipment shall be delivered fit to perform the functions stated above and therefore (if applicable) shall include any peripheral / accessory to ensure the offered equipment can function as stated above.

3. External Interfaces

3.1 Electrical Interfaces

4. CNC Press Brake Bending Machine Installation
