TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR PLUMBING

TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A SERVICE PROVIDER TO PROVIDE PLUMBING REPAIR, MAINTAIN, REPLACE AND INSTALLATION FOR SOUTH AFRICAN SOCIAL SECURITY AGENCY (SASSA) HEAD OFFICE ON A MONTH TO MONTH NOT EXCEEDING A PERIOD OF TWO (2) YEARS AS AND WHEN REQUIRED.

1. BACKGROUND

- 1.1 SASSA was established in terms of the South African Social Security Agency Act, 2004 (Act no. 9 of 2004) to administer social security grants in terms of the Social Assistance Act, 2004 (Act no. 13 of 2004). The Agency is mandated to ensure effective and efficient delivery of service of high quality with regard to the management and administration of social grants such that the entire payment process and system from application to receipt of social grants by a beneficiary, is done in a manner that is sensitive, caring and restores the dignity of the beneficiaries as well the integrity of the whole system.
- 1.2 According to Section 8 (1) of the Occupational Health and Safety Act, Act, 1993 (Act no. 85 of 1993), as amended, the Agency is required to provide as far as reasonably practicable, a working environment that is safe and without risk to the health of its employees.
- 1.3 SASSA is therefore in a process to appoint a service provider to render a service for Plumbing repair, maintain, replace and installation for SASSA Head Office in Prodinsa and Pencardia 2 Buildings.

- 6.2 Company to have minimum one (1) year related experience

- 6.3 Team leader to have at least a minimum of two (2) years working and related experience with CV's of the team leader to be attached.
- 6.4 The service provider must be registered with Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB) in 1 SO or higher class.

11. CONDITIONS OF THE BID

- 11.1 All work to be done by a qualified and registered person
- 11.2 Provide the necessary documentation as requested prior to the awarding of the contract.
- 11.3 Comply with all relevant employment legislation and applicable bargaining council agreement, including UIF, etc. SASSA shall monitor compliance for the duration of the contract and implement penalties for non-compliance.
- 11.4 Manage the internal disputes among his/her staff such that SASSA is not affected by those disputes
- 11.5 Ensure that all staff working under this contract are fit and pose no risk to any SASSA employees.
- 11.6 Comply with All SASSA policies, procedures and regulations.

- 1.5 Failure on the part of a bidder to submit proof of B-BBEE Status level of contributor together with the bid, will be interpreted to mean that preference points for B-BBEE status level of contribution are not claimed.
- 1.6 The purchaser reserves the right to require of a bidder, either before a bid is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by the purchaser.

- (c) "bid" means a written offer in a prescribed or stipulated form in response to an invitation by an organ of state for the provision of goods or services, through price quotations, advertised competitive bidding processes or proposals;
