1 Responses to RFQ

2 Formal Briefing

There is be no briefing session for this RFQ.

3 PROPOSAL SUBMISSION

Transnet has implemented a new electronic tender submission system, the e-Tender Submission Portal, in line with the overall Transnet digitalization strategy where suppliers can view advertised tenders, register their information, log their intent to respond to bids and upload their bid proposals/responses on to the system.

 - Submit bid documents by uploading them into the system against each tender selected.

4 Communication

- 4.2** It is prohibited for Respondents to attempt, either directly or indirectly, to canvass any officer or employee of Transnet in respect of this RFQ between the closing date and the date of the award of the business.
- 4.3** Respondents found to be in collusion with one another will be automatically disqualified and restricted from doing business with organs of state for a specified period.
- 4.4** Respondents may also, at any time after the closing date of the RFQ, communicate with the contact person specified in Section 1 of this RFQ on any matter relating to its RFQ response:

9 Disclaimers

9.1 Respondents are hereby advised that Transnet is not committed to any course of action as a result of its issuance of this RFQ and/or its receipt of a Quotation in response to it. Please note that Transnet reserves the right to:

- modify the RFQ's goods / service(s) and request Respondents to re-bid on any changes;
- reject any Quotation which does not conform to instructions and specifications which are detailed herein;
- disqualify Quotations submitted after the stated submission deadline;
- not necessarily accept the lowest priced Quotation or an alternative bid;
- place an order in connection with this Quotation at any time after the RFQ's closing date;
- award only a portion of the proposed goods / services which are reflected in the scope of this RFQ;
- split the award of the order/s between more than one Supplier/Service Provider should it at Transnet's discretion be more advantageous in terms of, amongst others, cost or developmental considerations;
- cancel the quotation process;
- validate any information submitted by Respondents in response to this bid. This would include, but is not limited to, requesting the Respondents to provide supporting evidence. By submitting a bid, Respondents hereby irrevocably grant the necessary consent to Transnet to do so;
- request audited financial statements or other documentation for the purposes of a due diligence exercise;
- not accept any changes or purported changes by the Respondent to the bid rates after the closing date and/or after the award of the business, unless the contract specifically provides for it;

10 Specification/Scope of Work

9.1 BACKGROUND

Transnet requires an asset verification solution to achieve the following business goals relating to asset management:

- Asset tagging for ease of identification and accounting;
- Ability to trace assets from the asset register to assets on the ground ;
- Ability to trace assets from the workshops and offices to the asset register to ensure assets on the system correspond with those on the asset register, and vis-versa. Where there are differences, the Service Provider is required to provide exceptions reports.
- The Service Provider is required to provide comprehensive management of asset movement, including tracking of the location of assets;
- The Service Provider must provide timeous identification of damaged assets;
- The functionality of the verification solution must have the capability for adding predetermined asset condition, including stolen, obsolete, idle, untraced, transferred etc. assets
- The functionality must the capability to verify asset componentisation in alignment with the requirements of International Accounting Standard (IAS) 16 of International Financial Reporting Standards

The Service Provider verification solution must comply with Transnet security policies and POPI; Information obtained from Transnet remains the property of Transnet and cannot be distributed without the express written confirmation from Transnet. The Service Provider is required to keep information in a secure database from the supplier from which information can be downloaded and uploaded into Transnet SAP with the potential to host direct in Transnet, subject to development. The secure database must have the ability to be integrated to SAP.

- bi-directional Integration Capabilities with SAP is required.

9.2 DETAILED SCOPE OF WORK

The solution is required to have the following Capabilities:

- a. The solution must be able to import existing asset register into a secure central database
 - The solution must have the capability to upload information from SAP into a secure central database outside of SAP – this will include, but not limited to asset number, asset description, remaining useful life, location etc.
 - The information imported should be available to users on smartphones for selected

- b. Solution capability to create and print tags/bar codes linked to an asset number in the Central Database:
- The solution must have the capability to import SAP asset number into tag/ bar code creating system
 - The solution must have the capability to print a quality tag label that can be affixed to various types of assets for example furniture, machinery, ICT equipment, laptops, network assets, video conferencing equipment etc..
 - The solution must have the capability to link the information on the central database with the tag/ barcode to be printed
 - The solution must incorporate validation checks for bar code printing, for example only asset numbers maintained on the asset register can be printed.
- c. Solution capability to perform asset verification/scanning using own Smart phone
- The solution must have the capability for Smart phone application to scan bar codes
 - The solution must have the capability to verify existence and location of an asset by scanning of the barcode
 - The solution must have the capability for information from central database to reflect on application on Smart phone when scanning asset.
 - The solution must have the capability for a user to select his own cost centre or location for verification.
 - The solution must have the capability for users to confirm the existence, useful life, location and other required fields via smart phone application onto central database
 - The solution must have the capability for a user who has scanned an asset to select one of the following codes confirming the verification status of the asset:
 - YO -Verified and obsolete.
 - YIU - Verified and idle but will be utilised.
 - YIN - Verified and idle but will not be utilised.
 - OB - Verified and utilised outside the borders of RSA.
 - YINC - Verified, utilized but incomplete (applies to group / sets / bulk assets e.g. Tool sets, telemeters, radios, furniture.)
 - U - Untraced assets
 - US- untraced stolen assets
 - UT- untraced asset transferred to another location
 - VIU- verified through use
 - DE- Assets damage
 - The solution must have the capability for a user to accept or review the remaining useful life of an asset maintained in SAP.
- d. The solution must have the capability to generate and download assets reports which can be edited, filtered and uploaded onto SAP, including but not limited to the following reports;

- i. Verification progress reports showing numbers, percentages, detail of verified assets, unverified assets per various levels, Transnet Group Division, Operating Divisions, Business Functions, Cost centre/ Per Asset Class etc
 - ii. Number, Percentage, Detail of useful life of assets per various organisational levels i.e. Transnet Group Division, Operating Divisions, Business Functions, Cost centre
 - iii. Records of various fields of the asset register on the central database, including but not limited to:
 - iv. asset number, asset cost, date capitalised, assets location, condition, useful life, asset verifier, date of last verification of the asset, department the asset belongs, asset image
 - v. Flexibility to have full or partial asset register report (depending on selection), including the abovementioned fields
 - vi. Integration and comparison between the verification solution and the asset register
 - vii. Exception and progress reports
 - viii. Audit trail of changes and user who affected changes
- e. Master Data Maintenance, changes/ Other
- i. Update asset details and allow record changes of the asset in case of location change.
 - ii. Enable upload of information from the verification solution software on the smartphone/scanner to a separate secure central database
 - iii. Enable upload of information from central database to SAP
 - iv. Have ability for reports from central database, direct from scan to be integrated and uploaded into SAP

9.2.1. Deliverables

The following are the deliverables from the Service Provider:

- Portable Bar Code Printers, as and when required.
- High quality bar code labels that can be affixed to different types of assets
- Annual software licenses for the verification software that provides the capability as stated below under scope of work (license rate per user)
- Smart phone application for scanning of assets for users
- Download reports from central database and amend report fields for users

9.2.2. Data

All data that is shared, retrieved, and saved on Smart Phones, Applications, Cloud and Hardware Servers during and after the contract period shall belong to Transnet only.

11 Legal review

A Proposal submitted by a Respondent will be subjected to review and acceptance or rejection of its proposed contractual terms and conditions by Transnet's Legal Counsel, prior to consideration for an award of business.

12 Security clearance

Acceptance of this bid could be subject to the condition that the Successful Respondent, its personnel providing the goods and its subcontractor(s) must obtain security clearance from the appropriate authorities to the level of CONFIDENTIAL/ SECRET/TOP SECRET. Obtaining the required clearance is the responsibility of the Successful Respondent. Acceptance of the bid is also subject to the condition that the Successful Respondent will implement all such security measures as the safe performance of the contract may require.

13 National Treasury's Central Supplier Database

Respondents are required to self-register on National Treasury's Central Supplier Database (CSD) which has been established to centrally administer supplier information for all organs of state and facilitate the verification of certain key supplier information. Transnet is required to ensure that price quotations are invited and accepted from prospective bidders listed on the CSD. Business may not be awarded to a respondent who has failed to register on the CSD. Only foreign suppliers with no local registered entity need not register on the CSD. The CSD can be accessed at <https://secure.csd.gov.za/>.

For this purpose, the attached SBD 1 Form must be completed and submitted as a mandatory returnable document by the closing date and time of the bid.

14 Tax Compliance

Respondents must be compliant when submitting a proposal to Transnet and remain compliant for the entire contract term with all applicable tax legislation, including but not limited to the Income Tax Act, 1962 (Act No. 58 of 1962) and Value Added Tax Act, 1991 (Act No. 89 of 1991).

It is a condition of this bid that the tax matters of the successful Respondents be in order, or that satisfactory arrangements have been made with South African Revenue Service (SARS) to meet the Respondents tax obligations.

The Tax Compliance status requirements are also applicable to foreign Respondents/ individuals who wish to submit bids.

Where Consortia / Joint Ventures / Sub-contractors are involved, each party must be registered on the Central Supplier Database and their tax compliance status will be verified through the Central Supplier Database.

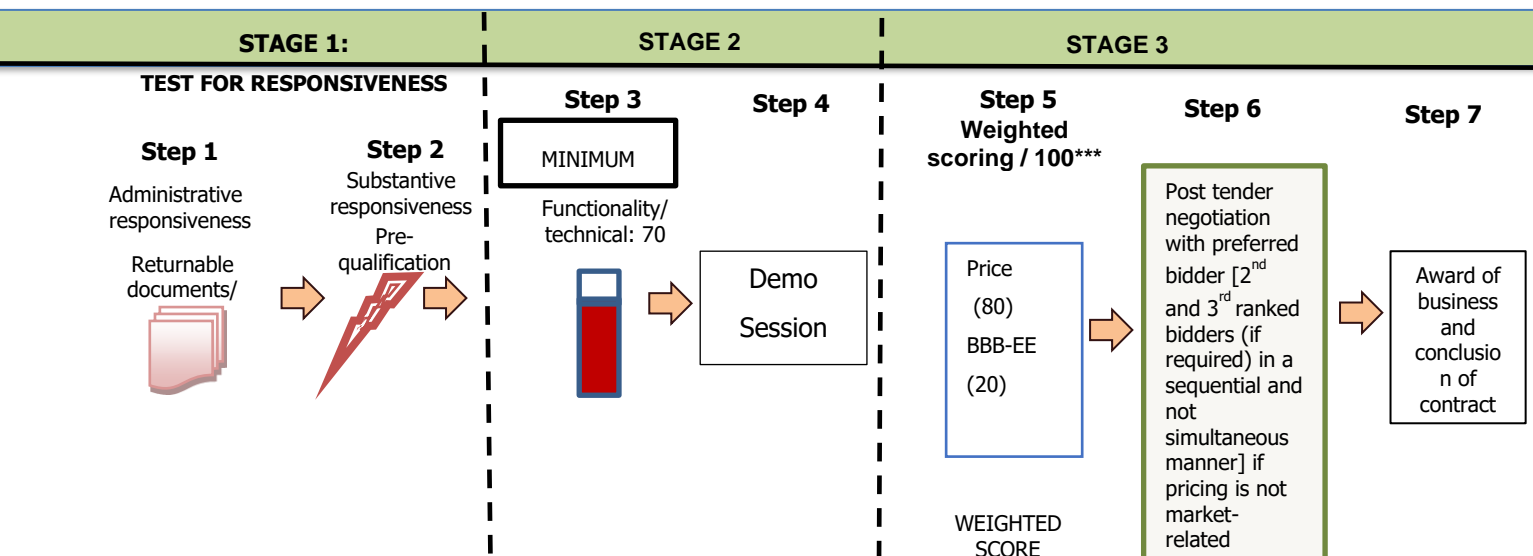

15 Evaluation Criteria

14.1 STEP ONE: Test for Administrative Responsiveness

The test for administrative responsiveness will include the following:

Administrative responsiveness check
Whether the Bid has been lodged on time
Bidder has signed SECTION 5: Certificate of Acquaintance with RFP Documents

The test for administrative responsiveness [Step One] must be passed for a Respondent's Proposal to progress to Step Two for further pre-qualification

14.2 STEP TWO: Test for Substantive Responsiveness to RFQ

The test for substantive responsiveness to this RFP will include the following:

Check for substantive responsiveness

Bidder has submitted a Priced Offer

B-BBEE - current scorecard / B-BBEE Preference Points Claims Form

Preference points will be awarded to a bidder for attaining the B-BBEE status level of contribution in accordance with the table indicated in **Section 4.1** of the B-BBEE Preference Points Claim Form.

14.6 STEP SIX: Post Tender Negotiations

Respondents are to note that Transnet may not award a contract if the price offered is not market-related. In this regard, Transnet reserves the right to engage in PTN with the view to achieving a market-related price or to cancel the tender. Negotiations will be done in a sequential manner i.e.:

first negotiate with the highest ranked bidder or cancel the bid, should such negotiations fail, negotiate with the 2nd and 3rd ranked bidders (if required) in a sequential manner.

In the event of any Respondent being notified of such short-listed/preferred bidder status, his/her bid, as well as any subsequent negotiated best and final offers (BAFO), will automatically be deemed to remain valid during the negotiation period and until the ultimate award of business.

Should Transnet conduct post tender negotiations, Respondents will be requested to provide their best and final offers to Transnet based on such negotiations. Where a market related price has been achieved through negotiation, the contract will be awarded to the successful Respondent(s).

14.7 STEP SEVEN: Award of business and conclusion of contract

Immediately after approval to award the contract has been received, the successful or preferred bidder(s) will be informed of the acceptance of his/their Quotation by way of a Letter of Award. Thereafter the final contract will be concluded with the successful Respondent(s).

Otherwise, a final contract will be concluded and entered into with the successful Bidder at the acceptance of a letter of award by the Respondent.

16 Validity Period

Transnet requires a validity period of 180 Business Days from the closing date of this RFQ, excluding the first day and including the last day.

Bidders are to note that they may be requested to extend the validity period of their bid, on the same terms and conditions, if the internal evaluation process has not been finalised within the validity period.
