Furthermore, I undertake to ensure that ETHEKWINI Municipality is timeously informed should the "mandatary", for whatever reason, be unable to perform in terms of this agreement.

The Contractor must, before the commencement of any work and during work, have risk assessment performed by a competent person appointed in writing; the contractor must have a documented plan and applicable safe work procedures to mitigate, reduce or control the risks and hazards that have been identified.

The Contractors must keep the risk assessment and writing safe working procedures in the safety file.

The Contractor shall ensure that all vehicles are in good working condition and safe for use, and that they are used in accordance with their design and intended use. The vehicles and plant shall only be operated by operators who have received appropriate training.

The Contractor/Service Provider shall ensure that his/her vehicles are Roadworthy Certified.

The Contractor shall ensure that all employees under his control are always wearing the appropriate Personal Protective Equipment.

The Contractor must be registered and in good standing with the Compensation Fund or a licensed Compensation Insurer, a proof of updated letter of Good Standing to be filed in the "Safety File"
