- Modify the RFQ's goods / service(s)/works and request Bidders to re-bid on any changes;
- Reject any Quotation which does not conform to instructions and specifications which are detailed herein; and
- Reject Quotations submitted after the stated submission deadline or at the incorrect venue.

Should a contract be awarded on the strength of information furnished by the bidder, which after conclusion of the contract, is proved to have been incorrect, PRASA reserves the right to cancel the contract. PRASA reserves the right to award businesses to the highest scoring bidder/s unless objective criteria justify the award to another bidder. Should the preferred bidder fail to sign or commence with the contract within a reasonable period after being requested to do so, PRASA reserves the right to award the business to the next highest ranked bidder provided that he/she/it is still prepared to provide the required goods at the quoted price.

9 LEGAL REVIEW

Proposed contractual terms and conditions submitted by a bidder will be subjected to review and acceptance or rejection by PRASA's Legal Counsel, prior to consideration for an award of business.

10 NATIONAL TREASURY'S CENTRAL SUPPLIER DATABASE

Bidders are required to self-register on National Treasury's Central Supplier Database (CSD) which has been established to centrally administer supplier information for all organs of state and facilitate the verification of certain key supplier information. PRASA is required to ensure that price quotations are invited and accepted from prospective bidders listed on the CSD. Business may not be awarded to a bidder who has failed to register on the CSD. 11 PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA

In responding to this bid, PRASA acknowledges that it may obtain and have access to personal data of the Bidders. PRASA agrees that it shall only process the information disclosed by Bidders in their response to this bid for the purpose of evaluating and subsequent award of business and in accordance with any applicable law.

Furthermore, PRASA will not otherwise modify, amend or alter any personal data submitted by Bidders or disclose or permit the disclosure of any personal data to any Third Party without the prior written consent from the Bidders. Similarly, PRASA requires Bidders to process any personal information disclosed by PRASA in the bidding process in the same manner.

13 ADMINISTRATIVE RESPONSIVENESS

The test for administrative responsiveness will include completeness of response and whether all returnable and/or required documents, certificates; verify completeness of warranties and other bid requirements and formalities have been complied with. Incomplete Bids will be disqualified.

14 VALIDITY PERIOD

14.1 PRASA requires a validity period of **90 Working Days** from the closing date.

14.2 Bidders are to note that they may be requested to extend the validity period of their response, on the same terms and conditions, if the internal processes are not finalized within the validity period. However, once the delegated authority has approved the process the validity of the successful bidder(s)' bid will be deemed to remain valid until finalization of the of award.).

Qualifying bidders shall then be evaluated on functionality after meeting all compliance requirements. The minimum threshold for the technical/functionality requirements is **70%** as per the standard Evaluation Criteria presented in Table 1 above. Bidders who score below this minimum requirement shall not be considered for further evaluation in stage 3.

OBJECTIVE CRITERIA

- 4.1** Section 2(1)(f) of the PPPFA empowers an organ of state to award a tender to the highest scoring bidder unless there is an objective criteria that justify the award to another tenderer.
- 4.2** PRASA reserves the right to apply the objective criteria for this bid.
- 4.3** PRASA may award a bid to a bidder that did not score the highest points under the following circumstances:
- A negative track record of the bidder in other related projects;
 - spreading the award to bidders that have not been previously appointed;
 - the need to avoid concentrating awards to the previously appointed bidders.
- Prasa shall take into account the following:
- the number of bid(s) awarded to the highest scoring bidder(s) in the preceding financial years;
 - the capacity of the highest scoring bidder(s) despite the previous appointments;
 - the value and scope of the bid(s) already awarded to the highest scoring bidder(s);
 - the materiality of the price difference between the highest scoring bidder and other bidders; and
 - whether the goods, services or works are of a specialised nature.

SPLITTING OF AWARDS

- 4.4** PRASA reserves the right to split the award of this bid to more than one service provider, provided that the nature of the services or goods or works to be provided are capable of being split to more than one service provider.

APPOINTMENTS OTHER THAN THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER

- 4.5** PRASA may appoint a bidder other than the successful bidder under the following instances:
- (i) When a successful bidder, after having been informed of the acceptance of its Bid, fails to sign a contract within a prescribe period of time e.g. 14 (fourteen) days after being called upon to do so;
 - (ii) When a successful bidder has failed to provide the necessary security, bonds or guarantees within the time required to do so by PRASA;
 - (iii) When a successful bidder fails to meet a condition precedent for the award of business (e.g. to obtain the necessary funding); and
 - (iv) When final contract negotiations with a preferred bidder fails and a contract is not agreed upon.
- 4.6** PRASA will only award a bid to a bidder other than the highest scoring bidder provided that such bid is still within the bid validity period.
- 4.7** Only if the second ranked bidder is also unable/unwilling, PRASA may proceed to the third ranked bidder.

1. General Signage Information Notes

Reference must be made to the PRASA Signage Guidelines and specifications, Version 9 for sketches and information on the Graphic language, sign type, sizes, samples and classification. All dimensions are specified in millimeters, unless shown differently.

Any bespoke signage requests to be addressed as per the specific site requirements. Some signage might in certain circumstances be illuminated in a normally non-illuminated environment.

Any deviations must be approved by a Prasa Agent from Prasa Cres, Design and Space planning and or Marketing.

2. Main task Signage

The vendor shall specify and supply all signage surfaces, sign structures, finishing, hardware, illumination, screens/panels, wiring (electrical), rigging and engineering as required assembling and installing signage configurations, described in this document.

Signage shall be assembled in such a manner as to allow for removal or reconfiguration. Signage units, depending on size, should be able to share components, ex, projecting vs facia etc.
