Background

MISA is committed to promoting sustainable environmental practices, reducing waste generation, and ensuring compliance with relevant environmental legislation and industry standards. Waste minimisation and remediation are key elements in achieving a cleaner production environment, reducing costs, and minimising the ecological footprint of operations.

To strengthen internal capacity and enhance environmental stewardship, the organisation seeks to appoint a suitably qualified and experienced service provider to deliver a five-day Waste Minimisation and Remediation Training Programme to selected employees.

1.	WASTE MINIMISATION AND REMEDIATION COURSE	
	The short course on Waste Minimization and Remediation is designed to explore various strategies that can be implemented to effectively utilize waste.	10 Officials
	The course should focus on environmental regulations that govern refuse collection and disposal, with an emphasis on recovery, reuse, and energy generation. It aims to enhance the technical knowledge of participants in Life Cycle Assessment (LCA) and the implementation of the 'Cradle to Grave' approach for proper product	

	development. Additionally, the course covers waste valorisation using pyrolysis and carbonisation processes, utilising both refuse and biomass waste streams as feedstock. Examples of products such as paper, plastic, cloth, tires, etc. will be used to demonstrate the benefits of considering LCA at the point of generation. The course also delves into other waste streams, including Marula, coconut, peanut, molinga, and wood bulk, and discusses their potential as GAC sources for water treatment and as energy storage materials for renewable energy sources such as solar and wind energy

	Service provider must provide at least 1 reference letters confirming that they have successfully delivered the required training in the last 3 years.			
	letter must have been written and signed by the representative (on client company letter heads) of the previous and or current client of the service provider confirming that the service provider has rendered required training in the last 3 years.			

- The contact details of the client writing the letters must be contained in the letters.
- The letters should clearly state which services were rendered by the service provider and the duration thereof.

4.2. Experience of the Facilitator:

- The facilitator must provide an abridged CV detailing proof that the facilitator has conducted the required training in the last 3 years.
- Registration with a recognised environmental professional body such as the Institute of Waste Management of Southern Africa (IWMSA), South African Council for Natural Scientific Professions (SACNASP), or equivalent, will be advantageous.
